29 Victoria – Chapter 19

**An Act to amend an Act passed in the Twenty-eighth Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, entitled "An Act to provide for the erection of Bridges across Colinet River, and Rocky River, on the main line of Road from St. John's to Placentia." (Passed 1st May, 1866.)**

Whereas it is expedient to amend an Act passed in the Twenty-eighth Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, entitled "An Act to provide for the erection of Bridges across Colinet River, and Rocky River, on the main line of Road from Saint John's to Placentia."

Be it therefore enacted by the Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, in Legislative Session convened, as follows:—

It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to authorize the appropriation and expenditure of the whole amount proposed to be raised by the hereinbefore mentioned Act, or so much thereof as may be necessary, in the erection and completion of one Bridge across the said Rocky River; and the provisions of the said Act for repayment of expenditure, and otherwise, shall apply to this Act.
