

## C A P. XXVIII.

AN ACT to continue for a limited time an Act passed in the fourth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act to repeal a certain Act therein-mentioned, and to regulate the measure and weight of Coals."

(29th March, 1826.)

**W**HEREAS it is expedient to continue an Act passed in the fourth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act to repeal a certain Act therein-mentioned, and to regulate the measure and weight of Coals," the duration whereof is limited to the first day of May, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-six: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower-Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "*An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec, in North America*;" and to make further provision for the Government of the said Province;" And it is hereby enacted by the authority of same, that the said Act passed in the fourth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act to repeal a certain Act therein-mentioned, and to regulate the measure and weights of Coals," shall continue to be and remain in force until the first day of May, one thousand eight hundred and thirty one, and no longer.

## C A P. XXIX.

AN ACT to authorize Robert Jones to build a Toll Bridge over the River Richelieu, in the Parish of Saint Luke at Saint Johns, near the Rapids, to fix the rates of Toll for passing thereon, and to provide Regulations for the same.
