HEREAS it is expedient to reimburse a certain sum of money expended by Edouard Larue of the City of Quebec, in the performance of the services herein after mentioned, May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, "An "Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His " Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act for making more effectual provision for the " Government of the Province of Quebec, in North America," and to make further " provision for the Government of the said Province," and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that it shall be lawful for the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, or person administering the Government, by warrant under his hand and out of any unappropriated monies in the hands of the Receiver General, to cause to be paid to the said Edouard Larue, a sum of money not exceeding eighty-eight pounds, fourteen shillings and nine pence half-penny, currency, to reimburse a like sum by him expended in distributing the printed copies of a certain Act passed in the ninth and tenth years of the Reign of His late Majesty, and intituled, "An Act for rendering valid conveyances of Lands and other immoveable property " held in free and common soccage within the Province of Lower Canada, and for
