2 William IV – Chapter 2

An Act to amend a certain Act therein-mentioned, relating to the encouragement of the Trade and Intercourse between this Province and the Province of Nova-Scotia. (25th February, 1832.)

Whereas certain of the Provisions and Enactments contained in a certain Act passed in the tenth and eleventh years of the Reign of His late Majesty, for the encouragement of the Trade and Intercourse between this Province and the Province of Nova-Scotia, have been found burthensome, and it is expedient to amend the said Act and to repeal a certain Section thereof;—Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower-Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great-Britain, intituled, "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, 'An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Québec, in North America,' and to make further provision for the Government of the said Province;" and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that the fourth Section of the said Act passed in the tenth and eleventh years of the Reign of His late Majesty, and intituled, "An Act to repeal a certain Act therein-mentioned, and for the encouragement of the Trade and Intercourse between the Ports of this Province and Halifax," which said Section is in the words following, that is to say, "And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that no such payment or advance shall be so made at the close of any season unless the said vessel and machinery shall have been insured until the close of the season then next following, in a sum not less than the said sum then to be advanced, and also any sum previously advanced" shall be and the same is hereby repealed.

II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the several sums of money mentioned in and payable under the authority of the said Act, may be paid to the person or company who shall have complied with the other provisions and requirements of the said Act, as hereby amended, although the Steam Vessel for which the said sums shall be claimed may, during the whole or any portion of the period of four years mentioned in the said Act, have been regularly navigated between the Port of Québec and other Ports of the River Saint Lawrence and the Port or Harbour of Pictou, in the Province of Nova-Scotia, instead of the Port or Harbour of Halifax aforesaid.
