C A P. XXXIV.

AN Act to continue for a limited time certain Acts therein mentioned.

[31st March, 1831.]

Preamble.

Certain Acts continued in force.

WHEREAS it is expedient that certain Acts herein after mentioned, should be continued for a limited time : Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower-Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great-Britain, intituled, “ An Act to repeal certain parts of “ an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, “ *An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of “ Quebec in North-America,*” and to make further provision for the Government of “ the said Province ;” And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that the Act passed in the ninth year of the Reign of His late Majesty, intituled, “ An Act to increase the number of Assessors for the Cities of Quebec and Montreal,” and a certain other Act also passed in the ninth year of the Reign of His late Majesty, intituled, “ An Act further to continue for a limited time, and to “ amend an Act passed in the seventh year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, “ An “ Act to continue and amend certain Acts therein mentioned,” establishing a Watch, and providing for the Lighting of the Cities of Quebec and Montreal, together with the Act so continued and amended by the said last mentioned Act, and also a certain Act passed in the ninth year of His late Majesty's Reign, intituled,

tuled, " An Act for the preservation of the Salmon Fisheries in the Counties of
 " of Cornwallis and Northumberland," and a certain Act passed in the tenth and
 eleventh years of His late Majesty's Reign, intituled, " An Act to continue further
 " for a limited time, a certain Act passed in the third year of His Majesty's Reign, in-
 " titled, " An Act to erect certain Townships therein mentioned, into an Inferior
 " District, to be called the Inferior District of Saint Francis, and to establish
 " Courts of Judicature therein, and to make further provision for the administration

 continued and shall be and remain in force until the expiration of this Act and no
 longer.

 and remain in force until the first day of May, one thousand eight hundred and
 thirty-four and no longer.

 " Ports in this Province, and for other purposes ;" and a certain other Act passed
