III. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the due application of the monies advanced pursuant to the directions of the present Act, shall be accounted for to His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, through the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury for the time being, in such manner and form as His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors shall be pleased to direct.

C A P. XVI.

An Act to amend and extend a certain part of An Act passed in the first year of His Majesty's Reign, Chapter eight, relative to the Internal Communications.

[3d April, 1833.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS by the first Section of An Act passed in the first year of His Majesty's Reign, chapter eight, intituled, An Act to appropriate certain sums of money therein mentioned, for the improvement of the Internal Communications of the Province, a certain sum of money was appropriated for erecting a Bridge over the River Saint Anne, in the County of Champlain, and whereas the said Bridge has not yet been erected, and whereas by the eleventh Section of the said Act it is enacted, that after the expiration of two years from the passing of the said Act, no contract shall be entered into, nor any work commenced under the authority thereof, and that such part or balance of the monies thereby appropriated as shall not be expended after the payment of all sums due on contracts entered into, or for days work performed under the authority thereof, shall remain at the future disposal of the Provincial Legislature, and whereas it would be expedient to extend the term fixed by the said Act in so far as relates to the said Bridge: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of, and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "*An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec, in North America,*" and to make further provision for the government of the said Province;" and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that the term fixed by the eleventh Section of the Act above cited, passed in the first year of His Majesty's

Reign, chapter eight shall be and is hereby extended until the expiration of two years from the time of the passing of this Act, in so far only as relates to the erection of the Bridge over the River Sainte Anne, and without derogating in any other manner whatsoever from the provisions of the said Act.

The site of said Bridge to be determined at a meeting of the Freeholders of said Parish, to be called for that purpose.

II. Provided always and be it therefore enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the site of the said Bridge shall be determined by the majority of the Freeholders resident in the said Parish, at a meeting to be called by a public notice posted on the door of the Church of the Parish of Saint Anne, during two consecutive Sundays or Holydays.

C A P. XVII.

An Act to grant aid to certain Charitable Institutions at Montreal.

[3d April, 1833.]

MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN.

Preamble.

MAY it please your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "*An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec, in North America,*" and to make further provision for the Government of the said Province;" And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that it shall be lawful for the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, or person then administering of the Province, to advance and pay by his Warrant or Warrants out of any unappropriated monies in the hands of the Receiver General of the Province, the following sums, that is to say: a sum not exceeding two hundred pounds currency, to the Ladies Charitable Society at Montreal, for the support of the Widows and Orphans placed under their care, a further sum not exceeding two hundred pounds currency, to the Ladies Benevolent Society at Montreal, for the support of the Widows and Orphans placed under their care, and a further sum not exceeding one hundred pounds currency to the Institution of the Orphan Asylum at Montreal for the support of the said Orphans.
