

Reign, chapter eight shall be and is hereby extended until the expiration of two years from the time of the passing of this Act, in so far only as relates to the erection of the Bridge over the River Sainte Anne, and without derogating in any other manner whatsoever from the provisions of the said Act.

The site of said Bridge to be determined at a meeting of the Freeholders of said Parish, to be called for that purpose.

II. Provided always and be it therefore enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the site of the said Bridge shall be determined by the majority of the Freeholders resident in the said Parish, at a meeting to be called by a public notice posted on the door of the Church of the Parish of Saint Anne, during two consecutive Sundays or Holydays.

C A P. XVII.

An Act to grant aid to certain Charitable Institutions at Montreal.

[3d April, 1833.]

MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN.

Preamble.

MAY it please your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "*An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec, in North America,*" and to make further provision for the Government of the said Province;" And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that it shall be lawful for the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, or person then administering of the Province, to advance and pay by his Warrant or Warrants out of any unappropriated monies in the hands of the Receiver General of the Province, the following sums, that is to say: a sum not exceeding two hundred pounds currency, to the Ladies Charitable Society at Montreal, for the support of the Widows and Orphans placed under their care, a further sum not exceeding two hundred pounds currency, to the Ladies Benevolent Society at Montreal, for the support of the Widows and Orphans placed under their care, and a further sum not exceeding one hundred pounds currency to the Institution of the Orphan Asylum at Montreal for the support of the said Orphans.

Certain sums of money granted for charitable Institutions at Montreal.

Application of the monies to be accounted for to His Majesty.

II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the due application of the monies appropriated by this Act, shall be accounted for to His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors through the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, in such manner and form as His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors shall be pleased to direct.

C A P. XVIII.

An Act further to continue for a limited time, and to amend a certain Act therein mentioned, relating to the Inferior District of Saint Francis.

[3d April, 1833.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to continue for a limited time and to amend the several Acts hereinafter mentioned: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "*An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Québec, in North America,*" and to make further provision for the Government of the said Province;" And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that a certain Act passed in the tenth and eleventh years of His late Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Act to continue further for a limited time a certain Act passed in the third year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Act to erect certain Townships therein mentioned into an Inferior District, to be called the Inferior District of Saint Francis, and to establish Courts of Judicature therein, and to make further provision for the due Administration of Justice in the said Inferior District," shall be and remain in force until the expiration of this Act and no longer.

Act 10th and 11th Geo. IV. cap. 7, continued and amended.

The Inferior District to be called, the District of St. Francis.

II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the said District heretofore called the Inferior District of Saint Francis, shall be hereafter called the District of Saint Francis.

Doubts removed as to suits on agreements entered into without the limits of the Province.

III. And whereas doubts have arisen whether the Judge of the Provincial Court of the said District of St. Francis, can of right hear and determine any suit or action founded upon any contract, agreement, bill, note or obligation made, executed or entered into without the limits of this Province; Be it therefore enacted and declared by
