CHAP. VIII.

An Ast for applying certain fums of Money therein mentioned to make good certain Monies issued and advanced by his Majesty, through his Honor Mr. President Grant, in pursuance of two addresses.

Passed 10th March, 1807.

Most Gracious Sovereign,

HEREAS in pursuance of several addresses of your Commons House of Assembly to his Honor Alexander Grant, Esquire, lately President administering the government of your Province of Upper Canada, bearing date the first and third of March one thousand eight hundred and fix, last passed, in the forty fixth year of your Majesty's Reign, several sums of money, amounting in the whole to the sum of one hundred and fifty-one pounds, two shillings and fixpence hallpenny, have been issued and advanced by your Majesty, through his Honor Mr. President Grant, to the Clerks and other officers of the two Houses of Parliament, for certain contingent expences attending the last Session of Parliament; - May it therefore please your Majesty that it may be enacted,—and be it enacted by the King's most excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Upper Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, entitled, " an Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of his Majesty's reign, entitled, "an Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec, in North America, and to make further provision for the Government of the faid Province," and by the authority of the same; That out of the furplus of any fund or funds subject to the disposition of the Parliament the Provincial of this Province, now remaining in the hands of the Receiver General unappropriated, there shall be issued and applied the sum of one hundred and fifty-one pounds, two shillings and fix pence halipenny, to make good the faid-tum or money which has been issued and advanced in pursuance of the Assembly. atorefaid addresses.
