46 George III – Chapter 2

An Act to repeal an Act passed in the thirty-fifth year of his Majesty's Reign, intituled, "*An Act to regulate the practice of Physic and Surgery*". Passed 3d March, 1806.

Whereas the provisions of an Act passed in the thirty-fifth year of his Majesty's reign, intituled, "*An Act to regulate the practice of Physic and Surgery*," are inexpedient in the present state of the Province; For remedy whereof, Be it Enacted by the King's most excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Upper Canada, constituted and Assembled by virtue of, and under; the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, "*An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of his Majesty's reign, intituled, "An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec in North America, and to make further provision for the Government of the said Province,"*" and by the authority of the same, That the said Act, intituled, "*An Act to regulate the practice of Physic and Surgery*," be, and the same is hereby repealed.
