An Ordinance to repeal a certain Ordinance, intituled, "An Ordinance to "declare that the second chapter of the Statute of the Parliament of "England, passed in the thirty-first year of the Reign of King Charles "the Second, is not, nor has ever been in force in this Province, and "for other purposes."

Preamble.

HEREAS circumstances render it advisable, that a certain Ordinance of the Administrator of the Government of this Province, authorized to execute the Commission of the Governor thereof, passed by and with the advice and consent of the Special Council for the affairs of the said Province, passed in the second year of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled, " An Ordinance to declare that the second " chapter of the Statute of the Parliament of England, passed in the thirty-" first year of the Reign of King Charles the Second, is not, nor has ever " been in force in this Province, and for other purposes," should be repeal. ed :-Be it therefore Ordained and Enacted by His Excellency the Governor of the Province of Lower Canada, by and with the advice and consent of the Special Council for the affairs of the said Province, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great-Britain and Ireland, passed in the first year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled, " An Act to make temporary provision for the Government of Lower Canada," and it is hereby Ordained and Enacted by the authority of the same, that the said Ordinance of the Administrator of the Government of this Province, authorized to execute the Commission of Governor thereof, and of the said Special Council for the affairs of the said Province, be, and the same is hereby repealed.
