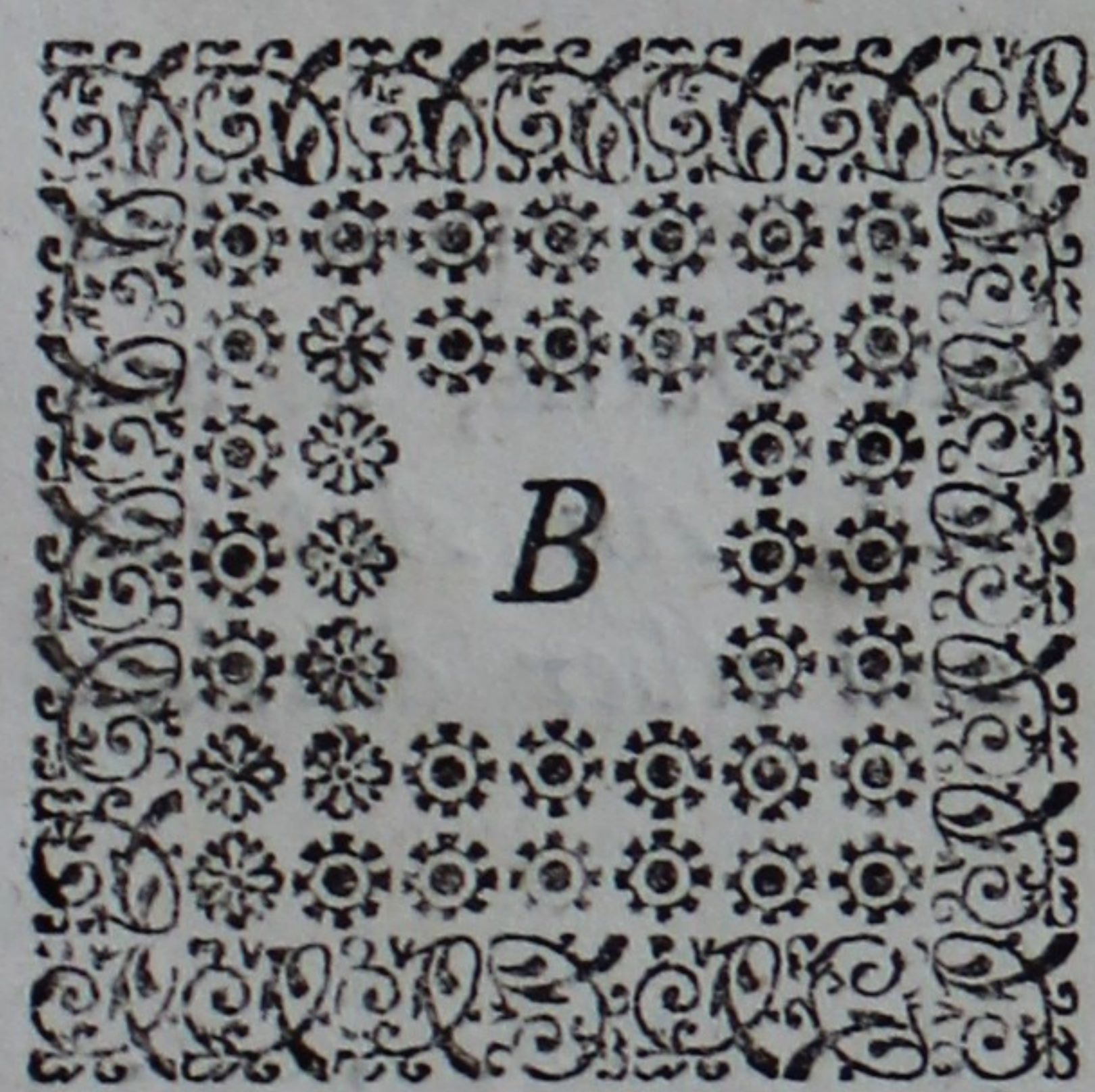


Be it enacted, by the Authority aforesaid, That all and every Person, having a Right to claim by Virtue of such Registry, (excepting the Persons Absent or neglecting to improve as aforesaid) shall be intitled to a full and absolute Estate in Fee Simple, in the Lands so registred, any want of Form in the said Registry notwithstanding.

*Be it enacted by his Excellency the Governor, Council, and Assembly, and by the Authority of the same it is hereby enacted, That an Act, intitled, “ An Act for
 “ confirming the past Proceedings of the Courts of
 “ Judicature, and for regulating the further Procee-
 “ dings of the same:” And also, “ An Act in Ad-
 “ dition to, and Explanation of an Act, intitled, An
 Act for confirming the past Proceedings of the Courts
 of Judicature, and for regulating the further Proceedings of the same; shall be and the same are hereby continued for One Year, from the Second Day of October, 1760, and from thence to the End of the then next Sessions of the General Assembly.*
