


An Act for Preventing fraudulent Dealings in the Trade with the Indians.

WHEREAS many Mischiefs may arise by Frauds and other Injuries, in the Trade with the Indians of this Province; and whereas the said Indians are unacquainted with the Laws of this Province, and in what Manner they are to proceed in order to do themselves Right.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly, That the Governor, Lieutenant-Governor, or Commander in Chief, upon Complaint of any Indians, within this Province, made to him or either of them, that they have been wronged or cheated of their Furrs or any other Merchandize, or in any other their Trade and Dealing with other his Majesty's Subjects; That the Governor, Lieuteuant-Governor, or Commander in Chief is hereby desired, to direct his Majesty's Attorney General to prosecute the same, either before his Majesty's Justices, or in any of his Majesty's Courts of Record in a summary Way, as the Laws do direct, and such Prosecution shall be deemed Legal, and Judgment and Execution shall issue accordingly.

This Act to continue and be in Force untill further Regulations relating to the Trade with the Indians shall be made.



An to Act prohibit for a limited Time the Exportation of Warlike Stores.

WHEREAS the Exportation of Warlike Stores of whatsoever Domination from this Province during the present War may be greatly Prejudicial to his Majesty's Subjects and the public Service, Be it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, the Council and Assembly, That no Person or Persons whatsoever during the Continuance of the present War shall directly or indirectly export, transport, carry, or convey
