E is enalted by the Lieutenant Governor, Council, and Affembly, that the Sum of One Hundred Pounds thall be afferded upon the Inhabitants of the Founds thall Hulitax for the Relief and Support of the Poor, belonging to the faid Township this Current Year; which Affersiment thall be made by Five perfons to be appointed Affers, by the Justices at the next Lap. 1

General Court of Quarter-Seffions of the Peace, to be held at Halifax, after Publication hereof, who shall Administer to them an Oath for the Due and Faithful execution of their Office, according to the best

of their Skill and Jüdgement. And if any Perfon fo Nominated and Appointed as aforefaid, shall Refute to be Sworn into the faid Office, he thall forfeit and pav the Sum of Five Pounds, and another shall be nominated and appointed in like manner in his stead. And the said Affessiment shall be regularly made out and Subscribed by the Affession, and being to Compleated they shall deliver the same to the Overleers of the Peor, who are hereby impowered and directed, to Collect and receive the sums to Affessical, from the Inhabitants of the faid Township according to their respective Rates as Afiessical, at Two payments, One Morety there we to be Collected as from as may be after the faid Affessiment shall be imade seand the remaining Morety, to be Collected immeulately after the Twenty starts Day of September next.

And in cale any of the faid Inhabitants shall neglect or Refuse to Pay the Sum they are so Assigned in, then faid Overseers are hereby impowered to sevy the same by Distress and Sale of the Goods and Chattels of the Person neglecting or refusing to Pay the same, together with all Charges attending thereon.

Provided always, that if any Perfon shall think himself agrieved by faid Assessment, he may bring his Complaint to the next General Court of Quarter-Sessions; where the same shall be Finally determined.

And it is further enacted, that the Overseers of the Poor shall Account upon Oath, to the Court of General Quarter-Sessions, for all such Money as they shall Receive by Vistue of this Act.

An Act in further ddition to and Amendment of an Act intitled, An Act for suppressing unlicensed Houses and for Granting to His Majesty a Duty on Persons hereaster to be licensed.

HEREAS fome difficulties have arisen in carrying into Execution several of the clauses of the Act intitled, "An Act "for Suppressing unlicensed Houses and for Granting to His "Majely a Duty on Persons hereaster to be licensed," for the conviction of Offenders against the said Act; For amendment whereof Be it enabled by the Lieutenant Governor Council and Assembly," That from and after the Publication hereos, If any person or persons whatfoever within this Province, either by themselves or any of their children, or known or reputed Servants or Substitutes under them, directly or indirectly, in any House, Shop, Warehouse, Storehouse or other place whatfoever belonging to the Father or Mother of such child or children, or to the known or reputed Master or Mistress of such fervant
