

Provided alway, That if any Proprietor or Proprietors of Lands, let out traprefeil, shall think hunfelf or herfelf aggrieved by the proceeding or any Justices of the Peace, in letting out his, her o. their Lands as aforelaid, such Proprietor or Proprietors by themselves or their Attornies or Agents, may Complain to the Justices in their General Seffins of the Peacer for faid County for Releif therein.

An Act to enable the Inhabitants in the several Town/bips in this Province, (HALIFAX exceptc.() to cause any absent Proprietor of Lands within the same, to pay a Dividend or Proportion of any County or Town Charge to be affessed according to Law, and to bear their just Proportion in repairing Highways, Roads, and Bridges within the faid Townships respectively.

WHERBAS there are many Non-resident Proprietors of Cap. 5. Lands within this Province, whose Lands are enhanced in their value by the Labour of these who are present, and the Burthen of the necessary County and Town Charges, being heavy on the resident Proprietors.

form E it enacted, by the Governor Council and Assem-B B bly, That each and every non-Relident Proprietor or Proprietors of Lands in any Township within this Province, (the Township of Halifax excepted, ) shall pay or Cause to be paid, his, her, or their just Dividend, of Proportion, of all County and Town Charges hereafter to be affeld in such County and Township, and upon Failure thereof, the same to be recover'd as directed by the Laws, impowering a such Assessment, and each and every non-Resident Proprietor or Propritors of Landsin any Township, shall be obliged to do and perform his.

her, or their Parts or Proportion of Libour on the Highways, Roads, and Bridges, within their Respective Townships, or pay for the fame as Delinquent Inhabitar is are by law directed.

And be it also enacted, That if any Proprietor or Proprietors of Lands in any Townships as aforetaid, shall be absent, and no Person appearing in their Behalf, on publick Notice being given in the Halifax Gazette, to pay his, her, or their Dividend or Proportion of any, Allessment made in Virtue of any Law of this Province, and to Labour on the Highways, Reads and Bridges, as aforefaid, and not having any Goods and Chattles, to answer his, her, or their Dividend, or Proportion of any Charge made as aforefaid, it shall and may be lawful for any one of his Majerly's Justices of the Peace, who are hereby impower'd to let out any past of such Delinquonts Lands, as may be stifficient to pay by the produce of the same, any such Dividend, Proportion or Charge so due; and in Case the Lands of such Absence, should not for the present, produce sufficient to pay the Lands of such Delinquent shall be held Chargeable therewith.

Provided always, That if any Proprietor or Proprietors of Lands, let out and held as aforefaid, shall think himself or herself eggieved, by the proceeding of any Justice of the Peace, in latting out his, her or their Lands as aforesaid; such Proprietor or Proprietors by themselves, or their Attorneys, may Complain to the Justices in their General Sefficies of the Peace, for said County, for Relief therein.
