ONLY HEREAS in and by the fifth Section of an Act, made in the Eighth Bear of his present Daiesty's Reign, intitled An Act for suppressing unlicensed Houses, and for granting to his Majesty a Duty on Persons hereafter to be licensed, it is Provided, That nothing in the said At thall extend to the preventing any Werchant, Shopkeeper, or other Person not ticensed to sell Liquors, from selling any Quantity of such Liquuzs not less than Five Gallons. whereas it is thought expedient to lessen the Quantity so permitted to be fold without Licence.

Preamble.

I. Be it enacted by the Governor Council and Acembly, That from and after the Commencement of this Act, nothing in the faid recited Act contained shall extend or be construed to extend to prevont or debar any Merchant, Shopkeeper or any Person not licensed to fell Rum or other distilled Spirituous Liquors, Wine, Ale, Beer, Cycler, or Perry from felling any Quantity of fuch Liquors, not less than Three Gallons, delivered at one and the same Time.

Persons not licensed may fell Three Gallons Rum &c.

Preamble.

- in the Eighth pear of his persent Hajesty's Reign, intitled An Act to amend render more effectual, and reduce into one Act the several Laws made by the General Assembly of this Province; relating to the Duties of Impost, on Beer, Rum and other distilled Spirituous Liquiers, It is Enacted, That all Rum of other Spirituous Liquiers, which that be issued for the Use of his Province Rang shall be deemed so far an Exportation thereof as to be intitled to a Drawback of Three pence per Gallon. And Albertas great Francs have been committed by the relaming or converting such Rum or other Spirituous Liquors to the Use of Persons on Shore, contrary to the Intent and Heaning of the said Indulgence.
- I. Be it enalted by the Court Council and Assembly, That from and after the Publication of this Act, if any Rum or other Spirituous Liquors on which the abovementioned Drawback shall have been received or claimed, shall after the same has been issued or pretended to be issued as aforesaid, be landed or converted to the Use of any Person or Persons on Shore, or for any other Use, than that of His Majesty's Navy, the same shall be forfeited, and the Person or Persons, who shall be found Guilty of committing such Fraud shall forfeit and pay a Fine of Fifty Ponnds, which Fine shall be sued for, levied and recovered in Manner as is prescribed and directed for other Fines and Penalties, in the aforerecited Act.
