 ✱✱✱✱ **B** That an Act made in the Tenth Year of his Present Majesty's Reign, intituled **An Act for granting to his Majesty a Duty of Impost on Loaf Sugar and Cider,** shall be, and continue from the Expiration thereof, and the same is hereby continued in Force, until the First Day of July, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy Two.

✱✱✱✱ **W** **HEREAS** in and by the Fifth Section of an Act, made in the Eighth Year of His present Majesty's Reign, intituled **An Act for suppressing unlicensed Houses,** and for granting to his Majesty a Duty on Persons hereafter to be licensed, it is **Provided,** That nothing in the said Act shall extend to the preventing any Merchant, Shopkeeper, or other Person not licensed to sell Liquors, from selling any Quantity of such Liquors not less than Five Gallons. **AND** whereas it is thought expedient to lessen the Quantity so permitted to be sold without Licence.

Preamble.

**I.** **As** it enacted by the Governor Council and Assembly, That from and after the Commencement of this Act, nothing in the said recited Act contained shall extend or be construed to extend to prevent or debar any Merchant, Shopkeeper or any Person not licensed to sell Rum or other distilled Spirituous Liquors, Wine, Ale, Beer, Cyder, or Perry from selling any Quantity of such Liquors, not less than Three Gallons, delivered at one and the same Time.

Persons not licensed may sell Three Gallons Rum &amp;c.

**II.** **And** be it Enacted, That an Act made in the Eighth Year of His present Majesty's Reign, intituled **an Act for suppressing unlicensed Houses**

Houses, and for granting to His Majesty a Duty on Persons hereafter to be licensed, with the Alteration thereto made by this Act, shall be and continue, and the same is hereby continued in Force, from the Expiration thereof, until the 1st Day of July 1773.

An Act in Amendment to, and for continuing the several Acts of the General Assembly of this Province, relating to the Duties of Imposit on Beer, Rum, and other distilled Spirituous Liquors.

Preamble.

HEREAS in and by the 22d Section of an Act made in the Eighth Year of His present Majesty's Reign, intituled An Act to amend render more effectual, and reduce into one Act the several Laws made by the General Assembly of this Province; relating to the Duties of Imposit, on Beer, Rum and other distilled Spirituous Liquors, It is Enacted, That all Rum or other Spirituous Liquors, which shall be issued for the Use of His Majesty's Navy shall be deemed so far an Exportation thereof as to be intituled to a Drawback of Three Pence per Gallon. And Whereas great Frauds have been committed by the relanding or converting such Rum or other Spirituous Liquors to the Use of Persons on Shore, contrary to the Intent and Meaning of the said Indulgence.

I. Be it enacted by the Governor Council and Assembly, That from and after the Publication of this Act, if any Rum or other Spirituous Liquors on which the abovementioned Drawback shall have been received or claimed, shall after the same has been issued or pretended to be issued as aforesaid, be landed or converted to the Use of any Person or Persons on Shore, or for any other Use, than that of His Majesty's Navy, the same shall be forfeited, and the Person or Persons, who shall be found Guilty of committing such Fraud shall forfeit and pay a Fine of Fifty Pounds, which Fine shall be sued for, levied and recovered in Manner as is prescribed and directed for other Fines and Penalties, in the aforesaid Act.

II. And be it Enacted, That an Act made in the Eighth Year of His present Majesty's Reign, intituled an Act to amend, render more effectual, and reduce into one Act the several Laws made by the General Assembly of this Province, relating to the Duties of Imposit on Beer, Rum and other distilled Spirituous Liquors, and the Act made in the Tenth Year of His said Majesty's Reign, in Addition to the said Act, with the amendment thereto made by the
