At the General Assembly of the Province of Nova Scotia, begun and holden at Halifax, on Tuesday the Twenty Eighth Day of May, 1765, in the Fifth Year of His Majesty's Reign, and there continued by several Prorogations until the Twenty Second Day of October, 1768, in the eighth year of His said Majesty's Reign; being the Seventh Session of the Fourth General Assembly convened in the said Province.

8 George III – Chapter 17 (Session 2)

An Act to repeal two Acts made in the Seventh Year of his Majesty's Reign, relating to the Duties of Impost and Excise.

Be it enacted by the Governor, Council, and Assembly, that the Act made in the seventh year of His Majesty's reign, intitled An Act to explain, amend, and reduce into one Act, the several Laws now in force relating to the Duties of Impost on Beer Rum, and other distilled Spirituous Liquors, and also the Act made in the seventh year of His Majesty's reign, intitled An Act to explain, amend, and reduce into one Act, the several Laws now in force relating to the Duties of Excise on Rum and other distilled Spirituous Liquors sold in this Province, be, and the same are hereby repealed.
