## C A P. III.

## An Act for raifing a Fund for the Purpose of making and repairing Bridges and Roads of Communication through the Province.

x444XbEREAS the Monies ariling from the Duty

Preamble.

are not sufficient to answer the Purpoles thereby intended in providing for the repairs of the 'Loads and Bridges in this Province, and whereas the Legislature has endeavoured by various Mays and Geans to caile a Fund, for so necesfary a Purpole, but without Effet;

I. Be it Enaged, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Allembly, That from and after the First Day of August of this prefent Year, there shall be raifed, levied, collected, and paid by every Housholder and Owner of Lands in this Province, who has held the same for one Year or upwards, (Glebe Lands and School Lands excepted) the several Taxes following, that is to fay, by every Housholder, Owner, or Proprietor, of any Quantity of Land not exceeding Five Hundred Acres, Two Shillings and Sir Pence, and by every Owner or Proprietor of Land exceeding Five Hundred Acres, at the rate of Six pence for each One Hundred Acres.

II. Provided always, and be it Enaded, That no Tax on any Perfon shall exceed the Sum of fifty Shillings in the whole, and if the Lands held by him shall be in feveral Counties, the fame shall be proportioned.

III. And be it Enaged, That the faid Taxes shall be affessed and levied upon every Proprietor, Tenant or Occupant of such Lands, agreeable to an Affess Roll to be made and returned in each County for that Purpose, and to be paid in Manner as herein after directed.

IV. and be it also Enaged. That the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, or Commander in Chief, for the Time being, be and he is hereby impowered, by and with the Advice and Confent of His Majefty's Council to appoint fuch, and fo many able and difcreet Perfons as to him shall feem meet, not less in Number than Three in each County, to be Commissioners or Directors of Roads in the respective Counties in this Province.

V. And be it further Enaged, That the Juffices of the Peace in the feveral Counties in this Province, shall at the General Sefstands of the Peace, or at a Special Sessions to be held for that Purpole,

pose, on or before the First Day of **Rovember** next, appoint two or more fit and sufficient Inhabitants as Affessions in each Township within the fame, and one or more responsible Persons being Inhabitants and Freeholders in faid County to be Collectors of Taxes in fuch County.

VI. And be it also further Enasted. That the faid Affeffors ihall, and they are hereby ditected to examine into and afcertain the Number of Housholders and Quantities of Lands liable to be affeffed by Virtue of this Act, in the Township for which they are appointed, and to form a Role of all fuch Housholders and Lands, which Role shall contain the Quantities of Land held by every Proprietor with the names of the Grantee, Tenant or Occupant, together with the Sums affeffed upon every fuch Proprietor, Tenant or Occupant carried out against their respective Names, which Role made in Form aforefaid, the faid Affeffors fhall duely return within the Space of Two Months from the Time of their Appointment, to the Juffices at an adjournment of the faid General Seffions of the Peace, or of the Special Seffions held for the Purpofes aforefaid in the refpective Counties, and Ten Days Notice shall be given of the faid Affefiment, by fixing up at the most publick Place in each Township, a List of the Persons Names and Sums so affessed, and no fufficient Caufe being fhewn to the contrary by the faid Perfons, within faid Ten Days, two or more of the faid Justices fhall approve of the faid affels Role by indorfing their Names thereon, and thall iffue their Warrant to the Collector, or Collectors with faid affeis Role annexed thereto, impowering them immediately to levy the fame, and the faid Collector or Collectors shall thereupon post up publick Notifications, advertising the faid Affeffment and afcertaining certain Times and Place of keeping an open Office for Receipt of fuch Affeffinent, not lefs than two Days in each Week for the Space of four Weeks.

VII. And be it Enaîted, That if any Affessor or Collector shall wilfully neglect or refuse to ferve or to perform his Duty in the due and speedy Exceution of this Act (not having lawful excuse) or shall be guilty of any Fraud or abuse in executing the same, he shall forfeit and pay a Fine not exceeding the Sum of **Cen Pounds** to be recovered on complaint of the said Commissioners or Directors or any two of them, before two of His Majesty's Justices of the Peace, and be levied by Warrant of Distress and Sale of the Offenders Goods and Chattels, and the said two Justices shall thereupon appoint another in his stead.

VII. And be it also Enaîted, That where any Lands rateable by this Act shall not be within any particular Township or County, or where any granted Townships are unfettled, and no fit Person or Persons are to be found thereon to be appointed Affeffors or Collectors, the Justices of the Peace for the County of HALIFAX, shall in such Case at their General Sessions, or at a Special Sessions

If Proprietor or Tenant refufes or neglects to pay Affeifment, Collector to diftrain.

Perfons aggrieved to appeal to General or Special Seffions, within Ten Days after Notice given of Affefiment.

to be held as aforefaid, appoint two fufficient Perfons refiding neareft or most contigious to fuch Lands, to affers the fame, who shall be governed and directed by the fame Rules, Orders and Directions, as are prescribed respecting other Lands, and the Affeffinent fo made shall be levied and collected by the Collector for the Township most contiguous to such Lands, or to the owner thereof, and by him be paid to the Commissioners or Directors for the County of Balifar.

IX. Provided always, and be it further Enaited, That where any Lands rateable by this Act, fhall be unoccupied, and no diffreffes can be found on the fame, nor the Perfon of the Owner or Proprietor can be found within the Province, by Reafon whereof the Tax and Affeffinent upon fuch unoccupied Lands cannot be levied, that then upon Complaint made thereof by the Collector to the Commiffioners or Directors for the County or Difirict, where fuch Lands lie, the faid Commiffioners or Directors fhall make return thereof to the Treasfurer of the Province, and fuch Lands shall be held chargeable for fuch Tax and Affeffiment until Diffrefs can be levied for the fame, or the Perfon of the Owner or Proprietor thereof can be found, to answer a process to be iffued for the fame as in Actions for Debt, and shall be fued for by the Treasfurer of the Province.

X. And be it also Enaged, That where any Proprietor of Lands living and refiding within the Province, his Tenant or Tenants, or the poffeffor or Occupant of fuch Lands, shall refuse or neglect to pay any Sum or Sums that shall or may be affeffed upon fuch Lands in virtue of this Act the Collector or Collectors of the County where such Affeffment is to be collected, is and they are hereby directed and authorized to enter thereon, and to destrain any Goods or Chattels, or other personal Estate to the amount of the Sum so affeffed, and to fell the same for Payment thereof, (Provided such Diffress is not redeemed in source Days) and the Surplus if any, after paying the Charge of Diffress and Sale, shall be paid to the faid Proprietor Tenant or Occupant.

XI. **And be it also fugther Enaged**. That in all Cafes where any Perfon or Perfons shall think himself, aggrieved by any Affessiment made as aforefaid, the faid Justices of the Peace at their General Sessions or Special Sessions to be held as aforefaid in each respective County, shall and they are hereby impowered to hear and determine all such Complaints, and to grant such Relief therein as to them shall feem meet, provided such Complaint be made within Ten Days after Notice given and demand made of the Affessiment due, which Determination of the faid Justices shall be Final. 1772. XII. and he it Enafted, That the Commiffioners or Directors aforefaid, in each County shall affers the Affers of the Townships in their respective Counties, and the faid Commissioners or Directors or any two of them within their faid Counties, shall and hereby required to call before them the Collectors, within each respective Division or Township, to Account for the Sums received by them in Pursuance of this Act, and to examine and affure themfelves of the full and whole Payment of the particular Sum and Sums of Money charged upon such Township, to the End there may be no Failure in the Payment of any part of the Afferssinent, nor any Arrears remaining, and in cale of any Failure in the Premission, the faid Commissioners or Directors or any two of them are hereby authorized and required to cause the fame to be forthwith levied and paid according to the true Intent and Meaning of this Act.

XIII. And is it also Enaited, That where any Tenant or Occupant, shall pay more than Two Shillings and Sixpence towards the Tax hereby imposed on the faid Lands, or shall have his Goods and Chattels distrained for the fame, it shall in such case be lawful for the faid Tenant or Occupant, to deduct such Tax so paid out of the Rent due or to become due, or for such Tenant or Occupant to recover the same from the Owner or Owners of such Lands by Action of Debt with Costs of Suit; Provided, That nothing herein contained shall make Void or alter any Contract made between any Landlord or Tenant, touching the Payment of Taxes or Affestiments.

XIV. And be it also further Enasted, That if any Perfon or Perfons whole Lands ought to be tax'd by Virtue of this Act shall by Suppression of any Grant, or by any Collusive Conveyance, or by any other Fraud or Covin, escape or avoid any Affessment and Payment, such Perfon or Perfons shall upon due proof thereof made before the Justices in their Sessions held for the County where such Lands lie, at any Time within One Year after such Affessment, made pay treble the Value of so much as such Lands ought to have been charged with by this Act, to be levied by Warrant of Distress and Sale of the Offenders Goods and Chattels.

XV. And be it further Enafted, That the Tax to be tailed collected and paid by Virtue of this Act, fhall be paid into the Hands of the Commiffioners or Directors, by the refpective Collectors, at fuch Times and in fuch Manner as fhall be prefixed by the faid Commiffioners or Directors, and the Collectors aforefaid fhall be allowed and paid upon the whole Sum fo collected and paid to the Commiffioners or Directors, One Shilling in the Pound, at the laft Payment by him or them fo made, and if any fuch Collector fhall neglect or refuse to Account for and pay to the Commiffioners or Directors aforefaid, all fuch Sum and Sums by him received Commissioners to assess the Assessors,

& call before them the Collectorstofaccount for the Sums received,

to examine & affure themfelves of the full Payment to be made,

no Arrears to remain.

Where Tenant pays more than 2s. 6d. it fhall be lawful for him to deduce the fame out of rent,

or recover the fame from Owner of Land, nothing herein to make void or altes any Contract.

If any Perfon by fupprefling a Grant, Fraud, &c. avoid the Affeffment, on proof thereof before Seffions to forfeit treble the value fuch + Lands ought to have been charged.

XVI. and be it Enaged, That every fuch Commissioner or Director, Assessment Collecter, before they respectively enter upon the Service of their faid Offices, shall take an Oath to the following effect before one of His Majesty's Justices of the Peace.

"Do folemnly fwear, that I will without Favor or Affection, "Hatred or Malice, truly and impartially to the best of my Skill and "Knowledge, execute and perform all, and every the Powers Autho-"rities and Directions established by an Act of the General Assembly "of this Province, made in the twelfth Year of his present Majesty's "reign, intitled, an Act for raising a Fund for the purpose of making and repairing Bridges and Roads of Communication thro' the Pro-"vince, fo far as the fame relates to and concerns the "Commissioners or Directors therein named.

XVII. and be it also Enaged, That the Monies hereby granted and which shall be raifed, levied, collected and paid in Pursuance of this Act, and all Fines and Forfeitures which shall be incurred, forfeited and paid by Offendersagainst the fame, shall be by the respective Commiffioners or Directors employed in the best & most frugal manner poffible in opening, clearing, amending, and repairing, the feveral Public Roads, Highways and Eridges, within their refpective Counties, and the faid Commissioners or Directors shall transmit an Account to the Treafurer of the Province of all fuch Monies fo received by them and how expended.

XVIII. And be it Enaded, That it shall and may be lawful for the Commiffiioners or Directors aforefaid, or any other Perfon or Perfons by their Order or Direction, to enter upon any unimproved Lands adjoining to or lying near the Publick Roads and Highways within their respective Counties, and to cut or open such Drains or Ditches thro' the fame as they shall judge necessary to carry off the ber, dig Gravel, Water from fuch Roads, and the faid Drains and Ditches fo cut and open'd shall be kept open by the faid Commissioners or Directors, as long as they shall judge necessary, and shall not be stopped or filled up by the Owners thereof, or any other Perfon or Perfons whatfoever, under the Penalty of Forty Shillings for every Offence, and the faid Commiffioners or Directors shall also have full Power and Authority in any unimproved Ground or Lands adjoining to the faid Publick Roads and Highways, to dig or caufe to be dug, any Gravel, Sand or Stones, or cut down any Wood or Trees thereon, as they shall think necessary for the Purposes aforefaid, all which shall be done with as little Injury and Damage as may be to the Owner of fuch Lands.

XIX. And be it also Enacted, That the Monies arifing by the Operation of this Act, shall be accounted for unto his Majesty in the Kingdom of Great-Britain, and to the Commissioners of his Majefty's Treasury or High Treasurer for the Time being, and Audited by the Auditor General of his Majesty's Plantations or his Deputy.

XX. And be it also Enasted, That this Act shall continue and remain in Force, for one Year from and after the Commencement thereof.

Monies raifed by this Act, Fines &c. to be employed by the Commissioners in amending &c. the Public Roads,

and transmit Account to the Treafurer of the Province.

Commissioners to cut drains or Ditches, and take Timimproved Land.

Monies accounted for to Commiffioners of Treasury, or high Treasurer, & audited by Auditor General of Plantations

To be in force for one Year.
