E it Enacted, by the Governor, Council and Assembly,
B That an Act, made in the Eighth Year of His present Majesty's Reign, intituled, *an Act for suppressing unlicensed Houses, and for Granting to his Majesty a Duty on Persons hereafter to be licensed,* and an Act made in the Eleventh Year of the Reign of his said Majesty, for altering and continuing the said Act, shall be, and continue, and the same are hereby continued in Force, from the Expiration thereof, until the Thirty First Day of *December* of this present Year, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy Three.

C A P. III.

An Act for amending and continuing an Act, made in the Twelfth Year of his present Majesty's Reign, intituled, an Act for raising a Fund for the Purpose of making and repairing Bridges and Roads of Communication thro' the Province.

E it Enacted, by the Governor, Council and Assembly,
B That "an Act made in the Twelfth Year of His present Majesty's Reign, intituled, an Act for raising a Fund for the Purpose of making and repairing Bridges and Roads of Communication thro' the Province," shall be, and continue, and the same is hereby continued in Force from the Expiration thereof, until the First Day of *July* of the Year of One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy Four.

Continued to 1st

And be it also Enacted, That from and after the First Day of *July* of this present Year, there shall be raised, levied, collected and paid, by every Householder and Owner of Lands in this Province, by and under the Limitations, Provisoos, Pains, and Penalties, and for the Purposes prescribed, directed and mentioned, in and by the said above recited Act, the like Rates and Taxes, as are imposed by the said Act.

III. *And be it Enacted*, That the Commissioners or Directors, or the Major Part of them, shall proceed on, and act in all Matters, relative to the carrying into Execution the said Act, any thing therein to the contrary notwithstanding.

C A P. IV.

An Act for Regulating the Fishery within the Harbour of *Halifax*.

E it Enacted, by the Governor, Council and Assembly,
 § B § That from and after the Publication of this Act, no person shall presume to set or affix any Net or Nets between *Jebueto-Head*, and the Head of the North-West-Arm, but from Sun-Set to Eight o'Clock in the Morning, and at the Distance of Fifty Yards from the Western Shore, and at least Fifty Yards from each other; leaving a Passage of Fifty Yards for Vessels to pass, under the Penalty and Forfeiture of Five Pounds, to be recovered on the Oath of one credible Witness, before any one of his Majesty's Justices of the Peace, or by view of the said Justice.

No Nets to be set but from Sun-set to Eight o'clock in the morning,

Distance from Shore & from each other prescribed.

Distribution & application of the Penalty.

II. *And be it further Enacted*, That all Penalties incurred and arising by this Act shall be applied, one Moiety to the Person who shall inform and Sue for the same, the other Moiety to be paid into his Majesty's Treasury for the Use of the Province, the same to be levied by Distress and Sale of the Offenders Goods and Chattels, together with the Charges of such Distress and Sale, rendering the Overplus (if any be) to the Owner or Owners thereof.

To be in force to the 31st December 1773.

III. *And be it also Enacted*, That this Act shall continue, and be in Force, until the Thirty First Day of *December* of the present Year One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy Three.

C A P. V.

An Act to prevent for a limited Time the Exportation or Shipping of Wheat, Rye, Barley, Flour, Meal, and Pease, from any of the Ports or Places in this Province, within the *Bay of Fundy*.
