An ACT to enable certain persons, therein named, to state an account of the work done in the Township of Truco, for repair of Dykes and Roads, fince the year One thousand seven hundred and fixty one, and to oblige the persons concerned in the same to pay their proportion of the faid expence.

At the GENERAL ASSEMBLY of the Province of Nova-Scotia, begun and holden at Halifax, on the Sixth Day of June, Anno Domini 1770, in the Tenth Year of the Reign of Our Sovereign Lord George the Third, of Great-Britain, France, and Ireland, KING, Defender of the Faith, &c. and there continued by feveral Prorogations until the Twentieth Day of October, Anno Domini 1775, in the Fifteenth Year of His said Majesty's Reign; being the Eighth Session of the Fisth General Assembly convened in the faid Province.*

This Act repealed by 35th Geo. An ACT in addition to the several Acts of this Province, made for regulating the Militia, and more particularly an ct made in the Second year of His present Majesty's reign, entitled, an Act for better regulating the Militia, on actual service, in time of War.
