KKK HEREAS in and by the eighth and ninth Sections of an Act made in the fecond Year of his Prefent Majefly's Reign, Intitled, an Act for the better regulating the Militia on actual Service in Time of War. It is enacted, that when any Part of the Militia shall be ordered to march from onePart of the Province or Town to another, not in the fame County to which they belong, on real Service, there shall be allowed and paid to the Com-missioned, non Commissioned Officers, Drummers and Private Soldiers, certains Sums therein mention'd, by which the Militia doing actual Duty within their own Towns and Counties, are excluded from receiving any Pay for that Service.

I. Be it therefore Enacted, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council, and Affembly, That there shall be paid to all Commissioned, Non-commissiond Officers, Drummers and Private Men, who shall herefore do actual Duty on real Service, within any Town or County in this Province, for follong as they shall remain and continue on faid Service the fameRate of pay, as is allowed to be paid by faid Act to the Said Officers, and others doing duty on real Service, not in the fame County, to which they belong.
