of eral B Affembly, That as foon as may be, after the Firft ges and B Affembly, That as foon as may be, after the Firft ges and ral Counties in this Province and in the Townships, impowered by Law to hold Special Sellions, shall meet together at such Flaces where the Selfions of the Peace are usually held, and allo within Six Months thereafter, taking into Confideration the Circumstances of the Times and Prices of Provisions, affects the Wages of all Artificers and Labourers, according to the best of their Judgment, for any Labour or Work to be done, by the Day, Week, Month or Year.

II. And be it Enacted, That the faid Justices, shall immediately after the faid Affeffment made, cause the fame to be certified under the Hand of the Clerk of the Peace, and posted up in the most public Places in the Several Townships within such County by the Provost Marshal or his Deputy, or one of the Constables.

III. And be it also further Emailed That if any perfor employing any Labourer or Artificer fhall offer or agree for, or give greater Wages than fhall be fo affeffed, every perfor convicted thereof, upon Complaint made before two Juffices of the Peace thall forfeit a Sum not exceeding Fifteen pounds nor lefs than Five pounds, for the Ufe of the Poor of the Township where fuch perfor refides, and be levied by Warrant of Diffress and Sale of the Offender's Goods, and if any Artificer or Labourer shall take and receive greater Wages than shall be fo affeffed, fuch Artificer or Labourer shall upon Conviction in manner afdressid, forfeit a Sum not exceeding Five pounds, nor lefs than Forty Shillings for the Ufe aforesaid, and on Non-payment thereof, be committed to the Goal, of the County or place where the Offence shall be committed for the Space of one Month.

IV. And be it Enacted, That this Act shall continue and remain in Force for one Year, and until the End of the Seffion of the General Affembly then next following.
