15 George III – Chapter 11 (Session 2)

An Act for continuing several Acts that are near expiring.

Whereas the several Acts hereunder mentioned are near expiring, and that it is necessary the same be continued.

Be it enacted, by the Governor, Council and Assembly, that an Act concerning Bail, and an Act made in the eighth year of his said Majesty's reign, intitled, an Act for altering amending and continuing the said Act, and an Act made in the Ninth Year of his said Majesty's Reign, in further amendment of the said Act, also, an Act made in the sixth year of his said Majesty's reign, intitled, an Act to prevent the Multiplicity of Law Suits, also an Act made in the sixth year of his said Majesty's reign, intitled, an Act for prescribing the Forms of Writs and the Manner of issuing the same, and an Act made in the eighth year of his present Majesty's reign, for altering, amending and continuing the said Act, and an Act made in the eleventh year of his said Majesty's reign for altering, amending and further continuing the said Act, also an Act made in the sixth year of his said Majesty's reign, intitled, an Act for the Establishment of Fees, as regulated by the Governor and Council, at the Request of the House of Assembly, and an Act made in the eleventh year of his said Majesty's reign in addition to the said Act, and an Act made in the fourteenth year of his said Majesty's reign, in further addition to, and for continuing the said Acts shall be and continue, and the same are hereby continued in force, from and after the end of this present session of the General Assembly for two years, and until the end of the session of the General Assembly, then next following.
