Innholders who domand or receive any greater Sum than 15 allowed by the Regulation to forfeit 405. for every Offonce. per or Innholder, shall forfeit the Sum of Forty Shillings, for every Offence, the fame to be recovered on the Complaint of any Person whatsoever, before any two of His Majesty's Justices of the Peace, for the County, where such Tavernkeeper shall live, to be levied by Execution on the Person or Goods of the Offender, one Half to go to the Informer, and the other Half to the Poor of the Town, where such Tavernkeeper shall live.

To continue in force for two Years. V. And be it further Enacted, by the Authority aforefaid, That this Act shall continue, and be in force for Two Years, to be computed from the End of the present Session of Assembly.

CAP. III.

AN ACT for continuing the feveral Laws relating to the Duty on licenfed Houfes.

Also an Att made in the Eighteenth Year of his faid Majesty's Reign, in Amendment of, and for continuing the faid Act, and an Act made in the Twenty Second Year of his faid Majesty's Reign in Amendment of, and for Continuing the faid Atts, shall be and continue, and the same are hereby continued in Force, until the Thirty First Day of December, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Eighty Four.

C A P. V.

An ACT for Establishing the Standard Weight of Grain and for Appointing proper Officers for Measuring Grain, Salt and Coals, and ascertaining the Standard Size of Bricks.

E it Enacted, by the Governor, Council and Affembly, and the B fame is hereby Enacted, That from and after the Publication hereof, the Juffices of the Peace in their feveral Seffions shall appoint two fit Perfons in each Township in this Province for the Purpose of Measuring all Grain, Salt, and Coals, and Inspecting all Bricks, that may be offered for Sale, and that all Grain exposed to Sale, shall not be deemed merchantable, unless it be of the following Standard Weight, to fay
