

At the General Assembly of the Province of Nova Scotia, begun and holden at Halifax, on the Sixth Day of June, 1770, in the Tenth Year of the Reign of Our Sovereign Lord George the Third, of Great Britain, France, and Ireland, King, Defender of the Faith, &c. and there continued by several Prorogations until the Sixth day of June, Anno Domini 1777, in the Seventeenth Year of his said Majesty's Reign, being the Fifth General Assembly convened in the said Province.

17 George III – Chapter 12

An Act for continuing the several Acts for raising a Fund for the Purpose of making and repairing Bridges and Roads of Communication thro' the Province.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and assembly, that an act made in the 12th year of his present Majesty's reign intituled, "An Act for raising a Fund For the Purpose of making and repairing Bridges and Roads of Communication thro' the Province," and an Act made in the 13th year of his said Majesty's reign for amending and continuing the said Act, shall be and continue, and he same are hereby continued in force from the expiration thereof until the 31st day of December, 1780.

II. And be it also enacted, that from and after the first day of January, one thousand seven hundred and seventy eight, and during the continuance of this Act, there shall be yearly raised, levied, collected and paid by every householder and owners or occupiers of lands in this province, by and under the limitations, provisoes, pains, and penalties, and for the purposes prescribed, directed and mentioned in, and by the said above recited Act, the like rates and taxes as are imposed by the said Act.
