At the General Assembly of the Province of Nova Scotia, begun and holden at Halifax, on the Sixth Day of June, 1770, in the Tenth Year of the Reign of Our Sovereign Lord George the Third, of Great Britain, France, and Ireland, King, Defender of the Faith, &c. and there continued by several Prorogations until the first day of November 1784, in the Twenty Fifth Year of his said Majesty's Reign, being the Fifth General Assembly convened in the said Province.

## An Act for continuing the several Acts herein after mentioned.

Whereas the several acts herein mentioned, will expire at the end of the present session of the general assembly, and that it is necessary the same be continued.

Be it enacted by the Governor, Council and Assembly, that an act made in the sixth year of his present Majesty's reign, intituled, "An Act to prevent the Multiplicity of Lawsuits;" also an Act made in the fifth year of his said Majesty's reign, intituled, "An Act for the Summary Trial of Action;" and also an act made in the eleventh year of his said Majesty's reign in amendment of the said act; also an act made in the fourteenth year of his Majesty's reign in addition to the said act; and an act made in the fifteenth year of his said Majesty's reign in further amendment of, and in addition to said act, also an act made in the same year, intituled, "An Act in further Amendment of the several Laws relative to the Summary Trial of Actions," also an act made in sixth year of his said Majesty's reign, intituled, "An Act for the Establishment of Fees as regulated by the Governor and Council at the Request of the House of Assembly;" also an act in addition to said act made in the eleventh year of his said Majesty's reign; also an act made in the fourteenth year of said Majesty's reign, in further addition to and for continuing the said acts; also an act made in the twenty second year of his said Majesty's reign, intituled, "An Act to raise a sum of Money towards keeping in Repair the Roads leading from Halifax to Windsor, and the District of Colchester;" also an act made in the twenty-third year of his said Majesty's reign, intituled, "An Act in Amendment of and for continuing an act made in the last session of the General Assembly of this Province, intituled, "An Act to raise a Sum of Money towards keeping in Repair the Roads leading from Halifax to Windsor and the District of Colchester," shall be and continue, and the same are hereby continued in full force unto the thirty-first day of December in the year of our lord, one thousand seven hundred and eighty-five.
