

At the General Assembly of the Province of Nova Scotia, begun and holden at Halifax, on the fifth day of December 1785, in the Twenty Sixth Year of his said Majesty's Reign, being the First Session of the Sixth General Assembly convened in the said Province.

26 George III – Chapter 4

An Act for continuing the several Laws therein mentioned.

Whereas the several laws herein mentioned are near expiring, and it is expedient the same should be continued.

I. Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor, Council and Assembly, and it is hereby enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the Act made in the fifth year of His Majesty's Reign, entitled "An Act for the Summary Trial of Actions together with the several laws in amendment thereof," also the act entitled, "An Act for the Establishment of Fees as regulated by the Governor and Council at the Request of the House of Assembly," together with the several acts in addition to, and amendment thereof, also the act entitled, "An Act in addition to, and Amendment of an Act for continuing the several laws, relating to the Duties on licensed Houses, and for the Appropriation of Monies raised thereby," also the act entitled, "An Act to exempt all Molasses, Rum, and other distilled Spirituous Liquors imported into this Province or purchased for the Use of His Majesty's Careening Yard or Navy from paying the several Impost Duties imposed thereon by the Laws of this Province," also the act entitled, "An Act in Amendment of, and for continuing an Act made in the last General Assembly of this Province entitled, 'An Act to raise a Sum of Money towards keeping in Repair the Roads leading from Halifax, to Windsor, and the District of Colchester,'" and every matter, clause and thing contained in all and every the before mentioned acts shall be continued, and the same are hereby continued until the first day of January, which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty seven, any thing in the said acts or either of them to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding.
