

At the General Assembly of the Province of Nova Scotia, begun and holden at Halifax, on Monday, the Second Day of October, 1758, and in the 32nd year of His Majesty's Reign.

32 George II – Chapter 22

An Act declaring what shall be deemed a Publication of the Province Laws.

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor, Council, and Assembly, and by the authority of the same it is hereby enacted, that the publick reading any law of this Province, by the Provost Marshal or his deputy, on the parade of Halifax, after notice by beat of drum, shall be deemed a efficient publication thereof.

And all laws, already published in that manner, are hereby declared to have been in force accordingly, from the time of such publication.
