## An Act for continuing an Act made and pass'd in the 4th Year of His Majesty's Reign, intitled "An Act for laying a Duty upon Billiard Tables and Shuffle Boards."

Be it enacted by the Commander in Chief, council and assembly, that an act, intitled, "An Act for laying a duty upon billiard tables and shuffle boards," shall be, and the same is hereby continued for three years, from and after the publication of this act, and from thence to the end of the then next session of the general assembly.

Publish'd according to law, the 5th July 1766.
