 lifax, on the Fifth Day of December, 1785 , in the Twenty Sixth Year: of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord GEORGE the Third of Great-Britain, France, and Ireland, King, Defender of the Faith, \&c: and there continued by feveral Prorogations unto the Sixth Day of June 1 791 , in the Thirty Firft Year of his Majefty's Reign, being the Sixth Seffion of the Sixth General Affembly, convented in the faid Province.
## CAP.I.

AN ACT, to provide for the Support and Maintenance of His Majefty's Government in this Province, by amending and continuing the feveral Laws, for railing a Revenue, herein after menribned.

 bereinafter mentioned, Sould be continued and amended.

1. Be it tberefors EnaEted, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and AF fermbly, That the Act; made in the Twenty Fourth Year of his prefert Majefty's Reign, intitled an Act, for more effectually raifing a Revoturit within this Province, for the fupport of its Government. Alfo; an Act, made in the'rwenty Fourth Pear of his faid Majefty's Reign, intitled an Act, for more effectually raifing a Duty of Excife on Winé,

Aets palfed in the $24^{\mathrm{h}}$, 26ih, 29'h and 30 h yeats onf his prefens $M$ jeft,'s Reigr, for raling : Revenue and Duly of Excife. Rum, and certain orther enumerated Articles; and for preventing Frauds ith the Collectioti of the Revenue. Alfo, an AEt, made in the Twenty Sixth Year of his faid Majefty's Reign, for continuing, and explaining faid Excife Act. Alfo, an Act, made in the fame Twenty Sixtf Year of his faid Majefty's Reign, to alter, amend, and continue, the faid Exefe-Ae. And alfo, an Act, made in the Twenty Ninth Year of his faid Majefty's Reign, intitled an Act, to provide K k k

Allo ACt for laying an Impolt Duty on Artacles imported from the Unitid States of America, conninued to sit July 1:92.

Alfo, an Act, made in the Thirtieth Year of his faid Majefty's Reign, in itled an $A E$, to provide for the fupport and Maintenance of His Maj, fy's Governmert in this Province, by reviving, amending and contin ing the feveral laws for raifing a Revenut, which are therem par ic alar'y mentioned, and expreffed. Alfo, an Act, made in the 1 wen:y Fourth Year of His faid Majefty's Reign, intitled an Aet, to exempt all Mos laftes, Rum, and other Diftilted Spiritious Liquors, imported into this Province, or purchafed for the Ufe of His Majelty's Cafeening Yard, or Navy, from paying the feveral Impait Duties impofed thereon, by the Lawsof this Province. And alfo, an Ast made in the Twenty Sixth Year of His faid Majefty's Reign, intitled an Act, to encourage and extend the Export, of Fith, Lamber, and other Produce of this Province tothe Weft-Indies, and alfo to revive, alter and continue the feveral Laws, relating to the Duties of Impoft on.Beer. Rum, and other Diftilled Spirituous Liquors, which Laws expired on the Thirty Firft Day of December, in the Year of Our Lord One Thoufand Seven Hundred and Eighty Four. Alfo, an Act, made in the fame Twenty Sixth Year of his faid Majefty's Reign, to alter the faidlait mentioned ACA. Alfo, an Act, made in the Twenty Ninth Year of his faid Majefty's Reign, intitled an 'Act, for the better fupport of the Poor, in the refpective Counties within this Province, by laying an Import Daty, on all Articles imported into this .Province, from the United States of America. All which faid feveral Aets, herein before particularly mentioned, and difcribed, and all, andevery matter, claufe, or thing therein contained, and which is not altered, or Amended by this AA, are hereby continued, in full forcound Virtue, until the Firft Day of fuly, which will be in the Year of Oufburd, One Thoufand Seven Hundred and Ninety Two.

And Wbereas the Collecting of the Revenuc, pajable by: Virtue of the faid foveral Aits berein before mentioned, in the County of Cumberland, and in the Diftrien of Colchefter, bas been atselided woitb rwitb-difficully, rubereby the Prozince bas fuffered a very great injurys fom Remedy, wocridf.
II. Be it Enacted, by the Autbority aforefaid, That it fray sand may belawful, for the Governor, Lieutenant Governor or Commander in Chief for the time being, from and after the Publioationheroof, to nominate and appoint the Juttices in their Seffons, in faind Sounty of Cumberland, and Diftrict of Colchefer, to be Collectors of the Revenue, in faid County of Cumberland, and Diftriet of Citchoiler, with power to appoint as many Depirties within their faid Diftricis, 25 they Thall think fit, and the faid Jutices in their Soffions, when appointed by the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, or, Commander in Chief for the time heing; Calleetors as aforefaid, and the Deputies -to be by
them appointed, Shald have full power, and Authority, to do, arid execute all, and every matter and thing what faever, neseffary and lawful to be done, fot the faithfal Colection of the Reyenue, in as full and ample a manner, as the Colfectors of Impoft and Exeifes have heretofore been accuftomed to do.

And for encouraging the Inbabitants of the foid County and Diffict, to aid the faid Juftices, in Colleefing the Revenuc.
III. Be it furtber Enatied, That there fhall be pait out of the Treafury of this Province, to the faid Juftices, over and above the ufual Commiffiuns allowed by Law for collexting the Revenue, the Sum of Thirty Five Pounds, for every One Hundred Pounds, which fiall be by them collected within their faid Diftricts, refpectively, and paid into the Treafury of this Province, which Sum or Sums fo to be Faid out of the Treafury, to the faid Juttices, תall be expended in repairing the Roads, and Bridges, within fuch County, and Diffrict, in fuch Manner, as the faid Juffices and the Grand Jury, for fuch County and Difrict, (hall appoint.
IV. And be it furtber Enefted, That the Collectors of Impont and Excife, fhation, no Account whatroever, receive from any Perfon or Perfons, any Warrant or Warrants, on the Treafury of this Province, or any other Provincial Security or Certificate, in Payment of any Debt ot Duties, which fhall be payable to fuch Collettors, by any + Perfon or Perfons whatfoever, after the Firf Day of fuly next, but all Debts or Duties due to the Government of this Province, on the Tid Firt Day of fuly, or which fhall become due afrerwards, fhall be : paid to the Treafurer or Collectors, in the current Specie of this Prowince. Anty Law, Ufage or Curtom, to the contrary Notwithftanding.

And whereas it is neceffary that the Treafurer of the Province, and ail Perfons emplayed in collecting any of the Revenue of this Province, fould Five good Security, for the faithful performance of the Truft repofed in them.
$V_{y}$ : Be it therefore Enafieds That it Chall not : be lawful, for any Perfon or Perfons, to execute the Office of Treafurer, or Collector or Collectors of Impoit and Excife in this Proviace, or any part there'of; unlefof fích Peffon or Petfons, fhall bave given Band to His MajeRty, his Feirs, and Sreceffors, "with two : fufficient Sureties joined thereln; for the Faithful poffomance of fuch Office, fuch Bonds ref. - pectivelyne be giveti on or before the Firft Day of October next.

And the Bond, given by Micibal Wai. tace, for certain Impoft-Duties, on a Quantity of Rum, imported from the Illand of Grenada, in the Schooner St. Fobn's Packet, Malacby O'Laugblan, Mafter. And the Bond, given by fobn Lawofon, for certain Impoft Duties, on a Quantity of Rum, imported from Grenada, in the Sloop Betfey, Fobrs Sbields, Mafter. And the Bond, given by I imotby Folger, for certain Import Duties, on a Quantity of Rum, and Sugar, imported in the Year, One Thoufand Seven Hundred and Eighty Eight, from Grenada, in the Brigantine Somerfet, Benjamin Swift, Mafter, ihall be cancelled, and given up, by the Collectors of Impoft and Excife, to the refpective Perfons herein before named.
VIII. And be it furtber EnaEled, by the Autbority aforefaid, That the Monies arifing from the Duties, impoled by this, and every other Act, of the General Afembly, thall be paid, and applied, in manner, and form as thall be directed, in, and by the Appropriation Act of the prefent Seffion for the Services of the Current Year. An that in Cafe the Treafurer of the Province, or other Perfon, fhall pay, or apply fuch Monies otherwife, than the fame fhall be appropriated, in and by fuch $A C$, the faid Treafurer or other Perfon, fhall be liable to, and Shall pay to, any Perfon or Perfons, who thall fue for the fame, double the Sum fo paid, otherwife than the fame thall be appropriated as a: forefaid.
IX. And be it furtber Enaifed, That this Act, and all and every Matter, and thing hercin contained, fhall be and continue in full force and Virtue, until the Firft Day of July, which will be in the Year of our Lord, One Thoufand Seven Hundred and Ninety Two.
