31 George III – Chapter 11

An Act, for altering the Time appointed for holding the Inferior Court of Common Pleas and General Sessions of the Peace, in the County of Cumberland, in the Spring of the year.

Whereas the time for holding the inferior court of common pleas and general sessions of the peace at Amherst, in the county of Cumberland in the month of April has been found inconvenient.

I. Be it enacted, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, that the said inferior courts of common pleas and general sessions of the peace for the county of Cumberland, shall for the future be annually held at Amherst in the said county, on the 2d Tuesday of June, and last Tuesday of October, any law, usage or custom to the contrary notwithstanding.
