## An Act for altering the Times of holding the Supreme Court in the County of Annapolis, King's County and the County of Hants.

Be it enacted, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, that the Supreme Court of judicature, court of assize and general goal delivery, shall for the future be held annually, in the months of May and Sept. at Windsor in the county of Hants on the third Tuesday of said months; at Horton in King's county on the Monday next following, the sitting of said court at Windsor; and at Annapolis, in the county of Annapolis, on the Monday next following, the sitting of said court at Horton; any law, usage or custom to the contrary notwithstanding.

II. And be it further enacted, that all writs and other process that may have been issued out of the clerk's office, returnable at Annapolis, on the third Tuesday of September next, and at Horton, on the fourth Tuesday of said month, and at Windsor, on the first Monday of October next, shall be returnable at the sitting of the said court at Windsor, on the third Thursday of September next, at Horton, on the Monday next following, and at Annapolis, on the Monday following.
