29 George III – Chapter 3

An Act for altering the Times appointed for holding the Court of Common Pleas and General Sessions of the Peace in the County of Sydney.

Whereas the states periods for holding the court of common pleas and general sessions of the peace at Guysborough, formerly called Manchester, in the county of Sydney, have been found extremely inconvenient to the inhabitants of said county for remedy whereof.

I. Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, that the court of common pleas and general sessions of the peace, shall be in future held at Guysborough, formerly called Manchester, in said county, on the second Tuesday in February and second Tuesday in August, annually, any law, usage or custom to the contrary notwithstanding.
