

At the General Assembly of the Province of Nova Scotia, begun and holden at Halifax, on the Twentieth day of March, 1793, and continued by several Prorogations to the 6th Day of June, 1797, in the 37th Year of the Reign of Our Sovereign Lord George The Third of Great-Britain, France, and Ireland, being the Fifth Session of the Seventh General Assembly convened in the said Province. From Richard John Uniacke, The Statutes at Large passed in the General Assembly held in His Majesty's Province of Nova Scotia: A complete index and abridgement of the whole. John Howe and Son, 1805.

37 George III – Chapter 5

An Act in amendment of an Act, passed in the twenty-ninth year of His present Majesty's Reign, entitled, "An Act for altering the Times appointed for holding the Court of Common Pleas, and the General Sessions of the Peace, in the County of Sydney."

Whereas the times, specified in the afore recited act, for holding the Inferior Court of Common Pleas, and General Sessions of the Peace, within the county of Sydney, have been found inconvenient to the inhabitants of the said district; for remedy whereof:

I. Be it enacted, by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Assembly, that the court of general sessions of the peace, and inferior court of common pleas, shall, after the present year, be held at Guysborough, in the said county, on the first Tuesday of March, and first Tuesday of October, annually. Any law, usage or custom, to the contrary notwithstanding.
