THEREAS it is expedient that the several Acts herein mentioned be further continued : I. Be it therefore enacted, by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Affembly, That an Act made in the fifth year of His prefent Majefty's reign, entitled, an Act for the fummary trial of actions, and the feveral Acts that have been made in explanation or alteration of the fame; alfo, an Act, made in the twenty-fixth year of His prefent Majefty's reign, entitled, an Act to enable one or more Juffices of the Peace to iffue computory process in the first 'instance in civil caufes which are by Law triable before them ; alfo, an Ast, made in the faid twentyfixth year of His Majesty's reign, entitled, an Act in addition to, and amendment of, an Act to prevent nuifances by hedges, wears, and other incumbrances, obstructing the passage of fifh in the rivers of this Province ; alfo, an Act, made in the thirty-third year of His Majefty's reign, entitled, an Act to amend an Act, paffed in the fixth year of His Majefty's reign, entitled, an Act for regulating the times and places for holding the feveral Courts of Juffice therein named, and also to enable the Supreme Court to alter and fix the return of writs; alfo, an A& to revive a Law for empowering the Governor, Lieutenant-Governor, or Commander in Chief for the time being, to prohibit the exportation of gun powder, arms and ammunition, or falt petre, or carrying the fame coaftways; alfo, an Act, passed in the same year, entitled, an Act for providing for the trial of Isfues by Justices of Nifi Prius in the Counties of Sydney, Lunenburg, Queen's County, and Shelburne ; alfo, an Act, paffed in the fame year, to regulate the packing and infpection of falted beef and pork for exportation; alfo, an Act made in the thirty-fixth year of His Majefty's reign, entitled, an Act to regulate the affize of bread; also, an Act, paffed in the fame year, entitled, an Act to enable the inhabitants of the feveral towns in this Province to raife money for the finking of wells, and fupplying the fame with pumps, and for keeping them in repair; also, an Act, passed in the thirtyeighth year of His Majefty's reign, entitled, an Act respecting aliens coming into this Province, or reliding therein ; allo, an Act, paffed the fame year, entitled, An Act for regulating the exportation of red or fmoaked herrings, and in amendment to an Act, paffed in the fecond year of His Majefty's reign, entitled, an Act for regulating the exportation of fifh, and the fize of barrels, hoops, boards, and all other kinds of lumber, and for appointing officers to furvey the fame ; alfo, an Act paffed in the fortieth year of His Majefty's reign, entitled, an Act in amendment of an Act, paffed in the thirty-fifth year of His Majefty's reign, entitled, an Act to amend and reduce into one Act the feveral Acts made by the General Affembly, relating to the office of Sheriff: and, alfo, for altering the form of the Summons heretofore ufed ; alfo, an Act to revive, amend, and continue an Act paffed in the thirty-fixth year of His Myefty's reign, entitled, an Act in addition to an Act, made in the fifth year of His Majefty's reign, entitled, an Act for railing money by prefentment on the feveral Counties in this Province for the defraying of certain county charges therein mentioned; alfo, an Act, paffed in the fortieth year of His prefent Majefty's reign, entitled, an Act to revive and continue an Act, made in the thirty-eighth year of His Majefty's reign, entitled, Act to amend, and render more effectual, an Act, passed in the eighteenth year of His Majefty's reign, entitled, an Act to prevent the foreftalling, regrating,

and monopolizing of Cord Wood in the Town of Halifax; alfo, an Act to alter and amend an Act, paffed in the thirty ninth year of His Majefty's reign, entitled, an Act for repairing or rebuilding the Market Houfe, erecting a Country Market, and regulating the feveral Markets in the Town of Halifax : and, alfo, to revive, alter, and amend, and bring into one Act, the Act for preventing frauds by Butchers and Fishmongers ; and the Act, made in the thirty. fourth year of His late Majefty's reign, for regulating and eftablishing a public market in the Town of Halifax ; alfo, an Act, paffed in the forty-third year of His prefent Majefty's reign, entitled, an Act to continue and amend an Act, entitled, an Act to revive, continue and amend, an Act, paffed in the fecond year of His Majefty's reign, entitled, an Act to regulate the fummary trial of actions before His Majefty's Juffices of the Peace, in the Town and Peninfula of Halifax; also, an Act, paffed in the forty-fourth year of His Majefty's reign, entitled, an Act in addition to and amendment of an Act, paffed in the thirty-fifth year of His prefent Majefty's reign, entitled, an Act to amend, and reduce into one Act, the feveral Laws now in being relating to a Militia in this Province : and every matter, claufe and thing contained in all and every of the abovementioned Acts, and alfo, in fuch Acts as have been made in explanation, amendment or alteration, of any or either of the fuid Acts, or for the purpole of reviving the fame, shall be continued in force until the thirty-first day of December, in the year of our Lord, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Six:

CAP. XIII.

An Act for establishing a Circuit Court in the County of Lunenburgh, and District of Pictou, and for amending the feveral Hels now in force relative to the Circuit Courts.

BE it enacled, by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Affembly, That a Seffions of the Supreme Court fhall be held annually at Lunenburgh, in the County of Lunenburg, on the fecond Tuesday of August; and at Pictou, in the District of Pictou, on the second Tuesday in June, and shall not fit longer at either place than five days.

II. And be it further enacled, That the Circuit Courts in the Counties of Hants, King's County, Annapolis and Cumberland, and in the Diffrict of Colchefter, fhall, in future, be held on the refpective days following, that is to fay—At Windfor on the third Tuefday of September; at Horton on the fourth Tuefday of September; at Annapolis on the Tuefday next after the fitting at Horton; at Truro on the first Tuefday of June; and at Amherst, in the County of Cumberland, on the third Tuefday in June; any law, usage or custom, to the contrary notwithstanding.

III. And be it further enacled, That, from and after the paffing of this Act, the Inferior Courts of Common Pleas, and General Seffions of the Peace, for the faid Diftricts of Colchefter and Pictou, fhall refpectfully hold their fecond fittings in each year, upon the day after the adjournment of the Supreme Court; and that the Inferior Court of Common Pleas, and General Seffions of the Peace, for the County of Cumberland, fhall hold their firft fittings in every year, upon the day after the adjournment of the Supreme Court at Amherft; and that the Grand and Petit Juries returned for the Supreme Court in the Diftricts and County aforefaid, fhall refpectively ferve for the faid Inferior Courts of Common Pleas, and General Seffions of the Peace, for the Diftricts and County aforefaid, in like manner as if they had been fummoned for the fame; and that fuch writs as may have been, or fhall be, iffued, returnable to any of the the faid Courts; fhall be returned on the refpective days herein before appointed for the fitting of fuch Courts; and all fuch writs, hereafter to be iffued, fhall be made returnable on the fitting of fuch fittings refpectively, and the parties flaall be bound to appear in Court accordingly.
