And be it further enacted, That in cafe any unforefeen accident has happened, or should happen, to any of the Bridges or Caufeways on the great public Roads of the Province, fo as to interrupt Travellers, it shall be lawful for his Excellency the Lieutenant Governor to order a Commissioner or Commissioners to repair or rebuild fuch Bridge or Bridges, or Caufeways, or to remove any other unforefeen obstruction that may impede travelling. And the Houfe of Affembly

pledges itself to provide for the expence, not exceeding the fum of 400l. the Commissioner or Commissioners accounting for the expenditure thereof. And it shall be lawful for the Lieutenant Governor, from time to time, to draw Warrants on account, in favour of fuch Commissioner or Commissioners, provided the faid fum or fums to drawn on account for fuch fervices shall not exceed the fum of Four Hundred Pounds.

And be it further enacted, That the feveral Officers of Government, who have Salaries provided for them by this Act, for the year one thousand eight hundred and four, and the year one thousand eight hundred and five; up to the first day of July, in the present year one thousand eight hundred and fix shall be paid at the fame rate for and unto the thirty-first day of December, in the fame year one thousand eight hundred and fix.

And be it further enacted, That the ninth, tenth, twelfth, thirteenth, fourteenth, fifteenth, fixteenth, eighteenth, nineteenth, twentieth, and twenty-first Sections or Clauses of the Act, made and passed in the forty-first year of his Majesty's reign, entitled, " An Act for applying certain monies therein mentioned for the fervice of the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and one, and for appropriating fuch part of the Supplies granted in this Seffion of General Affembly, as are not already appropriated by the Laws or Acts of the Province" fhall be and continue in full force and virtue, until the thirty-first day of December, which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fix, in as full and ample a manner as the fame claufes would be were the fame again herein repeated word for word.

CAP. II.

And whereas certain articles made liable to duties by the faid Acts, or fome of them, may have been

imported into this Province fince the expiration of the faid Acts, and it is expedient that fuch articles, for imported, fould be subject to, and pay, the said duties :

II. Be it therefore enacted, That it shall and may be lawful, for the Collectors of Impost and Excife, in the feveral Ports and Diffricts of this Province, immediately after the publication of this Act, to proceed to the warehouse or wharehouses, veffel or veffels, of fuch perfon or perfons who may have made importations of Wine, Rum, Sugar or Molaffes, to caufe an account to be taken, and an entry to be made, of all fuch articles refpectively, as fhall have been imported into this Province, fince the thirty-first day of December last, and which shall remain the property of any fuch Importer, not being lefs than fifty gallons of Wine, or Rum, or other diffilled Spirituous Liquors, or Molaffes, or two hundred weight of Brown Sugar, to be paid, or fecurity to be given, for the faid duties (the additional Impost Duties excepted) in manner directed by the faid Acts respectively.

III. And be it further enacted, That if, after the publication hereof, any fuch Importer shall fell, transfer or remove, any articles whatfoever fo imported, and which by this Act are made fubject to duty, without having entered the fame and every part thereof, then remaining in his pofferfion, or being his property, with the Collectors of Import and Excife for the Diftrict or Place where fuch importations shall have been made ; and if any quantity of the faid articles, exceeding fifty gallons of Wine, Rum, or diffilled Spirituous Liquors, or Molaffes, or two hundred weight of Brown Sugar, shall be found in the hands, custody, or possession, of any fuch importer or ftockholder, without having been duly entered as aforefaid (after account fhall have been taken by the Collectors of Impoft and Excife as aforefaid) and the duties fecured as directed by the faid Acts herein before revived; all fuch articles fo found, or which shall be fo fold, transferred or removed, shall and may be feized and condemned, in the manner and form directed by the faid Acts, and fuch importer, fo felling the fame, fhall be liable to the feveral penalties and forfeitures imposed by the faid Acts, or any of them, on perfons clandeftinely landing fuch articles. •
