An A& to revive and continue an A& passed in the thirty-fecond year of His present Majesty's reign, entitled, an A& for the further increase of the Revenue, by raising a Duty of Excise, on all Goods, Wares, and Merchandize, imported into this Province; and, also, the A&, in amendment thereof, passed in the forty-first year of Hispresent Majesty's reign, entitled, an A&, to alter, amend, and continue, an A&, made and passed in the thirty-fecond year of His present Majesty's reign, entitled, an A& for the further increase of the Revenue. by raising a Duty of Excise, on all Goods, Wares, and Merchandize, imported into this Province.

Preamble.

Act continued to 31st Dec. 1806. III: REAS the above recited Acts have expired, and it is expedient that the fame should be revived and continued :

I Be it enacted, by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Affembly, That the faid Acts, and every matter, claufe and thing, therein contained, shall be revived, and continued, and the same are hereby revived, and continued in force until the thirty-first day of December, in the year one thousand eight hundred and fix, and no longer.

CAP. VI.

An Act to encourage the fitting out of Veffels in this Province, for carrying on the Bank and Cod Fisheries.

Size of Veffels entitled to Fifhing Bounty.

159. per Ton, Bounty.

Limitation of Bounties.

Owners of Fifhing Veffels to give Bonds.

DE is enacted, by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Affembly, That all veffels, owned by His Majefty's Subjects refident in this Province, duly registered and navigated according to law, and being of the burthen of twenty-five tons, being already registered; and all veffels, of the burthen of forty tons, hereafter to be registered, or upwards, which shall be fitted out in any port, or place, of this Province, to be employed in the Cod or Bank Fisheries, on the coast and fhores of Nova-Scotia, the Ifland of Cape-Breton. the Gulph of Saint Lawrence, Banks of Newfoundland, Streights of Belleifle, or Coaft of Labrador, and which thall actually be engaged, and employed, in the Fisheries, in, or upon, any of the faid coafts, or places, for the space of four complete calendar months, between the twentieth day of March, and first day of December, in any year, or years, during the continuance of this Act, shall be paid, and allowed, from the public Treasury of the Province, a bounty of Fifteen Shillings per Ton, for each and every Ton which fuch Veffels shall respectively admeasure, according to Register. Provided always, That the bounty to be paid to any one Veffel shall not exceed the fum of Seventy Five pounds; and, alfo, that it shall not be lawful for the Treasurer to pay more than the fum of Three Thoufand Pounds, in Bounties, by virtue of this Act.

And be it further enacted, That all and every perfon intending to fit out a Vefiel or Veffels, upon a fifting voyage, with an intention to obtain the bounty granted by this Act, fhall previous to the failing of the veffel on faid voyage, give bonds, at the Cuftom Houfe, to double the amount of the Bounty to which fuch Veffel would be entitled, with a Condition, there under written, for employing fuch veffels respectively in the faid Fishery during four Months, within
