### CAP. VII.

An Act to revive, and continue, an Act, made and passed in the twenty-ninth year of His present Majesty's reign, entitled, An Act for the better support of the Poor in the respective Counties of this Province, by laying an Impost Duty on articles imported into this Province from the United States of America.

**W**HEREAS *the above recited Act hath expired, and it is expedient that the same should be revived and continued :*

I. *Be it enacted, by the Lieutenant-Governor Council, and Assembly,* That the said Act, and every matter, clause and thing, therein contained, shall be revived, and continued : and the same is hereby revived, and continued in force until the thirty-first day of December, in the year one thousand eight hundred and six, and no longer.

### CAP. VIII.

### CAP. IX.

An Act for granting Two Thousand Pounds for the encouragement of the Agriculture of this Province.

**W**HEREAS *the Riches and Prosperity of this Province very much depend upon the improvement and encrease of its Agriculture :*

I. *Be it therefore enacted, by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly,* That any person or persons, being the owner or owners, tenant or tenants, occupier or occupiers, of any uncultivated Lands, who shall, between the first day of January, in the year one thousand eight hundred
