Also, an Act passed in the forty fourth year of his Majefty's reign, entitled, an Act in addition to and amendment of an Act, paffed in the thirty-fifth year of his prefent Majefty's reign, entitled, an Act to amend and reduce into one Act, the feveral Laws now in being relating to a Militia in this Province. And, alfo, an Act made in the forty-fixth year of his Majefty's reign, entitled, an Act in addition to and amendment of an Act made in the fortieth year of his prefent Majefty's reign, entitled, an Act in further addition to, and for altering and amending an Act passed in the thirty-fifth year of his prefent Majefty's reign, entitled, an Act to amend and reduce into one Act the feveral Laws now in being relating to a Militia in this Province; and every matter, clause, and thing, contained in all, and every of the above-mentioned Acts, and, also, in fuch Acts as have been made in explanation, amendment or alteration, of any, or either, of the faid Acts, or for the purpose of reviving the same, shall be continued in force until the thirtyfirst day of December, in the year of our Lord, One thousand eight hundred and feven, and until the end of the next Seffion of General Affembly.

CAP XIII.

An ACT in further amendment of an Act, made and paffed in the Thirty ninth year of His Majesty's reign, entitled, an Act for raifing a Revenue to repair the Roads throughout the Province, by laying a Duty on perfons hereafter to be licenced to keep Public Houses or Shops, for the retail of Spirituous Liquors, and for regulating fuch Public Houfes and Shops.

Licence Money collected out of the bounds of Halifax, to be paid into the Treasury, and applied on Roads were collected.

DE it enacted, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Affembly, That it shall and may be lawful, for the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, or Commander in Chief, for the time being, to caufe the Licence money, which shall hereafter be collected out of the bounds of the Township of Halifax, by the Clerk of the Licences for the County of Halifax, and paid by him into the Treasfury of the Province, pursuant to the directions of the faid Act, to be applied to the repair of the public Roads, within the Township or Place, wherein fuch Money shall have been collected. Any thing in the faid Act, to the contrary thereof notwithstanding.

CAP. XIV.

An ACT for granting an Annuity to John Newton, Efq. one of the Collectors of Impost and Excise, for the District of Halifax.

Preamble.

J. Newton, Efq.

HEREAS, John Newton, Efq. by reafon of his age and infirmities, is no longer able to difcharge the Duties of a Collector of Impost for the District of Halifax :

I. Be it therefore enacted, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Affembly, That from and after difcharged from the first day of January, One thousand eight hundred and feven, the faid John Newton shall be, and

and he is hereby declared to be, thenceforth, discharged from the faid Office of Collector of Impost and Excise, for the District of Halifax.

II. And be it further enacted, That there shall be granted and paid, out of the Treasury of this Province, unto the faid John Newton, or his Affigns, during the term of his natural life, an Annuity, or Pension, of Two Hundred Pounds per Annum, from the faid first day of January, One thousand eight hundred and seven ; to be paid quarterly, by Warrant for that purpose, to be drawn by the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, or Commander in Chief for the time being.

CAP. XV.

An ACT in further addition to, and amendment of an AA, made in the fecond year of his prefent Majesty's Reign, entitled, an AA for the appointment of Firewards, ascertaining their duty, and for punishing Theses and Disorders at the time of Fire.

HEREAS, it baving been found neceffary to provide more than two Fire Engines for the Town of Halifax, it becomes expedient to increase the number of Engine Men :

I. Be it therefore Enacted, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and diffembly, That it fhall be lawful for the Justices of the Peace, in their Seffions, for the Town and County of Halifax, to appoint a further number of different and prudent perfons as Engine Men, not exceeding Twelve, in addition to the number already appointed, or to be appointed, under the Act or Acts, whereof this is a further amendment; and fuch perfons shall be fubject to the duties, and entitled to all the privileges and exemptions, granted by the faid Acts to Fire Engine Men.

And whereas the prefent number of Firewards in the Town of Halifax has been found infufficient :

II. Be it enacled. That it fhall, and may be lawful, for the Juffices of the Peace in the Town and County of Halifax, to appoint a further number of different perfons as Firewards, not exceeding five, in the feveral parts of the faid Town of Halifax, who shall be for faithfully to difcharge their trust, and who shall be invested with all the powers and regulations, as are provided for, in, and by the feveral A cts aforefaid.

, III. And be it further enacled, That the exemption from working on the Highways, granted by Law, to Engine Men, in the Town of Halifax, be extended, and the fame is hereby extended, to Engine Men, appointed, or to be appointed by the aforefaid Acts, in the Towns of Annapolis, Windfor, Shelburne, Liverpool, and Lunenburg.

CAP XVI.

An ACT to regulate the appointment of Collectors, and other Officers of Impost and Excise.

B^E it enacted, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Affembly, That from and after the First day of January, One thousand eight hundred and seven, there shall be only one person appointed or employed, as Collector of Impost and Excise, for the District of Halifax, or any other District or Port in this Province.
