CAP. II.

AN ACT to regulate the Expenditure of Monies, hereafter to be appropriated, for the Service of Roads and Bridges.

Appointment of Commiffioners for Roads and Bridges.

Commiffioners removeable by the Governor with advice of Council.

Secretary to furnish Treasurer with lift of Conmiffioners.

Commissions to be ready in 20 days.

Commiffioners to give fufficient Security.

Juffices to certify to fufficiency of Sureties.

Commiffioners allowed 5 per cent.

Money voted for Roads and Bridges-how Treafury.

Commiffioners to prefer Contract.

If by days work, only 25 Labourers to be employed by one Commiffioner.

BE it Enacted, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Affembly, That, it shall and may be lawful, for the Governor, Lieutenant-Governor, or Commander in Chief for the time being, by, and with the advice, of his Majefty's Council, fome time between the firft day of January and Twentieth day of March, annually, to nominate and appoint fit and proper Perfons, being Freeholders, to Act as Commiffioners for directing and fuperintending the expenditure of fuch refpective fums of Money as have been, or may be granted, for the purpofe of making, or repairing Roads and Bridges, in the feveral Counties and Diftricts of this Province, wherein fuch Commissioners shall respectively refide.

II. And be it further Enacted, That it shall and may be lawful, for the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, or Commander in Chief for the time being, by and with the advice of His Majefty's Council, at pleafure, to remove all or any of the faid Commissioners, and to appoint from time to time in their place, others, being refident Freeholders as aforefaid; and the Secretary of the Province, shall furnish the Treasurer of the Province, with a list of the Names of fuch Commissioners, and the fums of money to be by them expended respectively; and alfo, fhall give due notice of all alterations made in the faid Commissions ; and shall alfo, immediately after fuch appointments are made, transmit notice thereof to the perfons appointed; and fhall, within Twenty days after fuch appointments, have the Committions for fuch Commissioners, and the Bonds to be entered into by them, ready for Execution.

III. And be it further enacted, I hat the Commissioners fo to be appointed as aforefaid, fhall, before entering upon the duties of the faid Office, give good and fufficient fecurity, by bond, with two fureties, to the fatisfaction of any two Juffices of the Peace for the County or Diffrict where fuch refpective Commissioners may be appointed, in double the amount of the fum to be expended under their direction, faithfully to lay out, and account, for fuch fum according And fuch Juffices shall Certify their approbation, and the fufficiency of fuch Sureto Law. ties, upon the back of the Bond, fo to be entered into, by the faid Commissioners ; and fuch Commissioners shall be entitled to retain, and charge in their Accounts, an allowance of five per Cent. out of the money to be expended as aforefaid.

IV. And be it further enacted, That each and every Commissioner, fo to be appointed as aforefaid, having given Security as herein before directed, shall be entitled to receive a War. rant on the Treafury, for the whole fum to be expended. And it shall, and may be lawful, iffued from the for the Treasurer to retain in his hands one third of the amount of fuch Warrant, where the work is to be done by days work, until one half the work is done and certified by the Commiffioner ; and in cafe of Contract, until the whole work is compleated, approved, and certified, according to Contract.

> V. And be it further enacted, That it shall be obligatory upon the Commissioners, to prefer Contract, generally, for the making and repairing fuch Roads and Bridges, to which they may be refpectively appointed; and in all cafes where the Commissioner shall judge it necessary to expend any fum of money by days work, there shall not be employed, in any one day, more than twenty-five Labourers to work under one Commissioner; and the Wages of all fuch perfons fo to be employed, thall be paid weekly, and in Cafh.

> VI. And be it further enacted, That when Contracts are intended to be entered into, due n tice thereof shall be given by the faid Commissioner, by posting up Advertisements, at le

ten days, in the places usual for public notices in the County, Township or District; and the faid Commissioners shall require and receive sufficient Security from the Contractor, or Contractors, for the performance of such Contract, within the time therein specified; and in all respects conform to the true intent and meaning thereof; and shall transmit to the Secretary of the Province copies of all Contracts made by such Commissioners; and the faid Commissioner, shall pay, and fatisfy, to such Contractor, from time to time, as the work shall be proceeded in, monies on account, until two third parts of the fum contracted for, shall have been paid and fatisfied; but it shall not be lawful to pay the remaining third part, until the whole work shall be completed and finiss agreeable to Contract, and certified as herein after directed. All which faid Contracts shall be made to expire, on or before the last day of October, in each year, in which such Contracts shall be entered into.

VII. VIII. And be it further enacted, That the Commiffioners appointed under this Act, fhall, refpectively account for all monies to be paid to them as aforefaid, in manner following, that is to fay; in forty days after the Bridge or Road work, for which fuch Commiffioner has been appointed, fhall be completed, he fhall transmit to the Secretary of the Province, an exact account of his expenditures, accompanied with the neceffary vouchers; in order that the fame may be examined, audited, and entered, previous to the fame being laid before a Committee of His Majefty's Council, and the Houfe of Affembly, to be finally approved, and paffed. And where any monies fhall be expended by days work, fuch Vouchers fhall conflit of weekly Pay-Bills, to be figned by the refpective Labourers for the monies received by them during fuch week; and all fuch Pay Bills, fhall be fubfcribed by one credible Witnefs, before whom fuch payments fhall be made.

IX. And be it further enacted, That this act shall continue, and be in force, for one year, from the publication hereof, and thence to the end of the next Session of General Assembly, and no longer.

CAP. III.

An ACT to encourage the raifing Bread Corn on new Lands.

HEREAS the Province is much drained of Current Specie by the introduction of Bread Corn: in order to encourage the exertions of the Settlers for raifing larger quantities of that necoffary article,

I. Be it enacled by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Affembly, That there fhall be allowed and paid for every bufhel of Wheat and Rye, of the Crop of the year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eight, which shall be raifed on any new lands, whereon the wood shall have been cut down, burned, and cleared off, after the first day of November last, the following bounties; that is to fay; for every bushel of Wheat, Ten Pence, and every bushel of Rye, Seven Pence half penny.
