

*At the General Assembly of the Province of Nova Scotia, begun and holden at Halifax, on Thursday the Sixth day of February, 1812, in the Fifty-second year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the Third, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, King, Defender of the Faith &c. &c. being the First Session of the Tenth General Assembly, convened in the said Province. From Henry H. Cogswell, The Statutes at Large passed in the General Assembly held in His Majesty's Province of Nova Scotia: from the Sixth Session of the Eighth General Assembly, to the Fifty-Sixth year of his Majesty's Reign. 52 George III – Chapter 12 (Session 1)

**An Act to alter the time of the Sitting of the Inferior Court of Common Pleas, for the County of Halifax.**

Whereas, it has been found inconvenient that the sessions of the peace and the court of common pleas, in Halifax, should be held at the same time, for remedy whereof:

I. Be it enacted, by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Assembly, that the inferior court of common pleas, of the county of Halifax, shall, from and after the publication hereof, be opened and held at Halifax on the second Tuesdays of June, September, December and March, annually, any law, usage or custom, to the contrary notwithstanding.
