Penalties how recovered.

IX. And be it further enacted, That all penalties and forfeitures for any offence against this Act, shall be profecuted, levied, recovered and applied, in the manner and according to the directions prescribed by the Act for Granting to his Majesty duties on wine, rum, and other distilled spirituous liquors, molasses, cossee and brown sugar.

X. And be it further enacted, That this Act, and every matter, clause and thing, therein Continuation of contained, shall be and continue in force until the sirst day of July, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fixteen, and no longer.
