

Penalties how recovered. IX. *And be it further enacted*, That all penalties and forfeitures for any offence against this Act, shall be prosecuted, levied, recovered and applied, in the manner and according to the directions prescribed by the Act for Granting to his Majesty duties on wine, rum, and other distilled spirituous liquors, molasses, coffee and brown sugar.

Continuation of Act. X. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act, and every matter, clause and thing, therein contained, shall be and continue in force until the first day of July, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixteen, and no longer.

CAP. XXI.

Expired. An ACT to continue in force the several Acts therein mentioned.

CAP. XXII.

Executed. An ACT for granting a Drawback on Wine, and distilled Spirituous Liquors.

CAP. XXIII.

Expired. An ACT to regulate the Trade of this Province in Plaster of Paris or Gypsum, and to prevent contraband Trade arising from the landing that article at or near the Boundary Line of the United States of America.
