it is considered necessary to provide for the more effectually carrying the said Act into execution:

Duties secured and made payable.

Frauds. .

II. Be it-therefore enacled, That the several duties imposed by the said Acts shall be secured. and made payable quarterly, in the manner directed in and by an Act, passed in the fifty-fith Year of His present Majesty's Reign, entitled, An Act for granting to His Majesty certain duties on Wine, Brandy, Gin, Rum, and other diffilled spirituous liquors, Molasses, Coffee and Brown Sugar, for the support of His Majesty's Government, and for promoting the Agriculture, Commerce and Fisheries, of this Province. And any person or persons who shall have in his or their possession; any goods, wares or merchandise, subject to the Excise Duty imposed thereon by the Acts hereby continued, of the Value of Fifty Pounds, or upwards, fuch person or persons shall be subject to the like penalties, and the goods to the like forfeitures; and fuch penalties and forfeitures profecuted, condemned, fued for and recovered, by the same ways and means, and be applied and distributed, as is directed in the said Act passed in the fifty sitch Year of his present Majesty's Reign, and the several rules and regulations contained in the lest mentioned Act for preventing frauds in collection of the several outies imposed in and by the said last mentioned Act shall be and the same are hereby applied to prevent frauds in collecting the duties of Excile imposed in and by the said Acts of which this Act is an amendment.

CAP. II.

An ACT to continue the several Acts of the General Assembly for raising a Revenue to repair the Roads throughout the Province, by laying a Cuty on Persons hereaster to be licensed to keep Public Houses and Shops for the retail of Spirituous Liquors.

Continued to March 18, 1819 E it enacted, by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Assembly, That an Act, passed in the thirty-ninth Year of His present Maj sty's Reign, entitled, An Act for raising a Revenue to repair the Roads throughout the Province, by laying a duty on persons hereaster to be licensed to keep public Houses and Shops for the retail of spirituous Liquors, and for regulating such public Houses and Shops. Asso the several Acts, passed in the fortieth, forty-first, forty-fixth, and sifty-sisth years of His Majesy's Reign, for reviving, altering, continuing, amending and adding to, the said Act, and every matter, clause, and thing, therein contained, be continued, and the same are hereby continued, until the Eightcenth Day of March, which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and nineteen, and no longer.
