7 Victoria – Chapter 15

An Act to empower the Justices of the Peace for the County of Gloucester, in their General Sessions, to regulate the Fisheries in the said County. Passed 25th March 1844.

Whereas the local situation of the Fisheries in the County of Gloucester render further and other regulations than those contained in the several Acts of Assembly for regulating the Fisheries in the different Rivers, Bays, Coves and Creeks of the Province necessary for carrying said Acts into effect; Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That it shall and may be lawful for the Justices of the County of Gloucester, in their General Sessions, to make such further regulations relating to the Fisheries in said County, as they may find necessary; Provided always, that such Regulations are not contrary to aim do not interfere with the general regulations and restrictions contained in any Act of Assembly or private right.
