At the GENERAL ASSEMBLY of the Province of Nova-Scotia, begun and holden at Halifax, on Thurfday, the Eleventh Day of February, 1819, in the Fiftyninth Year of Our Sovereign Lord GEORGE the Third, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great-Britain and Ireland, KING, Defender of the Faith, &c. &c. &c. being the First Session of the Eleventh General Assembly, convened in the said Province.*

CAP. I.

An ACT to continue the several Acts of the General Assembly, for raising a Revenue to repair the Roads throughout the Province, by laying a duty on Persons hereafter to be licensed to keep Public Houses for the retail of Spirituous Liquors.

E it enacled, by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Affembly, That an Act, passed in the thirty-ninth year of His present Majesty's reign, entitled, An Act for raising a Revenue 39th Geo. III. to repair the Roads throughout the Province, by laying a duty on Persons hereafter to be licensed to keep Public Houses and Shops for the retail of Spirituous Liquors, and for regulating such Public Houses and Shops; also, the several Acts, passed in the forty-first, fortyfix th and fifty-fifth years of His Majesty's reign, for reviving, altering, continuing, amending, cept 2d sec. of and adding to the said Act; and every matter, clause and thing, therein contained, except 55th Geo. III. the second section of the last mentioned Act, be continued until the eighteenth day of March, which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty, and no longer.

II. And be it further enacled, That an Act, passed in the fortieth year of His Majesty's reign, 40th Geo. III. entitled, An Act to continue and amend an Act, made and passed in the thirty-ninth year continued. of His present Majesty's reign, entitled, An Act for raising a Revenue to repair the Roads throughout the Province, by laying a duty on persons hereafter to be licensed to keep Public Public Houses or Shops for the retail of Spirituous Liquors, and for regulating such Public Houses and Shops, and every matter, clause and thing, therein contained, be, and the same are hereby, repealed.
