VI. And be it further enacted, That it shall and may be lawful for the Governor, Lieutenant-Governor, or Commander in Chief for the time being, to draw by Warrant on the Treafury, from time to time, for all such sums of Money as may become due and payable by virtue of the several Laws now in force for the establishing Schools in the Province.
