II. And be it further enacted, That there shall be drawn from the Treasury, the sum of fifteen pounds for the support of each School, (instead of twenty-five pounds) and no more, Continued to under the Provisions of the Acts hereby continued; any thing in the said Acts contained 31st March

to the contrary notwithstanding.

CAP. XXIII.

An ACT to alter and continue an Act, entitled, An Act to regulate the expenditure of Monies, hereafter to be appropriated for the service of Roads and Bridges; and also, an Act to alter and amend the faid Act.

E it enacted, by the Governor, Council and Affembly, That an Act, passed in the fifty-second year of His present Majesty's reign, entitled, An Act to regulate the expenditure of Monies hereafter to be appropriated for the Service of Roads and Bridges; and also, an Act, passed in the fifty-seventh year of His Majesty's reign, to alter and amend the said Act; and every matter, clause and thing, in the said Acts contained, shall be continued, except so far as the said Acts are hereby altered, and the same are hereby continued for one

year, and from thence to the end of the next Session of the General Assembly.

II. And be it further enacted, That no Labourer hereafter to be employed upon the Roads, shall be allowed or paid a greater sum than four shillings for each day's work; and no owner or owners of any Team, confisting of a Cart with a suitable driver, and two Horses or four Oxen, shall be allowed or paid a greater sum than ten shillings for each day; or of any Team, confisting of a Cart, driver and one Horse, or two Oxen, shall be allowed or paid a greater sum than seven shillings and sixpence, for each day employed on the said Roads: any Law, usuage or custom, to the contrary notwitstanding. Provided always, That every Commissioner shall procure Labour and Teams for a smaller rate of wages, than above mentioned, whenever he shall be able so to do.
