the Revenue, by raifing a Duty of Excise on all Goods, Wares and Merchandise, imported into this Province; also, the Act, made in the forty-eighth year of His said Majesty's Reign, for repezling so much of the aforesaid Act as exempts from such duty certain articles therein enumerated, and for declaring what Goods, Wares, and Merchandise, shall hereafter be exempt from such Duty of Excise; and also, the Act, made in the sifty fourth year of His present Majesty's Reign, entitled, An Act to continue the several Acts of the General Assembly for the further increase of the Revenue, by raising a Duty of Excise on all Goods, Wares, and Merchandise, imported into this Province; and also, the Act, made in the fifty-eighth year of His present Majesty's Reign, entitled, An Act to continue and amend the several Acts of the General Assembly, for the further increase of the Revenue, by III. raising a Duty of Excise on all Goods, Wares and Merchandise, imported into this Province; and every matter, clause, and thing, therein contained, be revived and continued; and the same are hereby revived and continued, until the twenty-fifth day of March, which will be in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty-one, and 25th March, no longer.

## CAP: III.

An ACT to continue an Act for granting a Drawback of the Duties on Brown or Raw Sugar used in the manufacture of Refined Sugar within the Province, and for regulating the mode of obtaining the same.

E it enacted by the Governor, Council and Assembly, That the Act, passed in the siftyseventh year of His Majesty's Reign, entitled, An Act for granting a Drawback of Act 57th Geo. the Duties on Brown or Raw Sugar, used in the manufacture of Refined Sugar within the Province, and for regulating the mode of obtaining the same, be continued: and every matter, clause and thing, therein contained, are hereby continued until the Continued to eighteenth day of March, which will be inthe year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred 18th March, and twenty-one, and no longer.

## CAP. IV.

An ACT for establishing a Public Market in the Town of Lunenburg.
