

At the General Assembly of the Province of Nova Scotia, begun and holden at Halifax, on Thursday the Eleventh day of February, 1819; and continued by several Prorogations until Thursday, the Tenth day of February, 1820, in the Sixtieth year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the Third, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, King, Defender of the Faith &c. &c. being the Second Session of the Eleventh General Assembly, convened in the said Province.

60 George III – Chapter 14

An Act to continue an Act, entitled, “An act for the Summary Trial of Actions;” and also, the Act in addition to and amendment thereof.

Be it enacted by the Governor, Council and Assembly, that an act, passed in the fifty-eighth year of His Majesty’s reign, entitled, An Act for the Summary Trial of Action; also, an act, passed in the fifty-ninth year of His Majesty’s reign, in addition to and in amendment thereof; and every matter, clause and thing, in the said acts contained, shall be continued, and the same are hereby continued, for one year, and from the end of the next sessions of the General Assembly.
